Seminar Task for Students of the Course Public Finance 2

- 1. Each student works by herself/himself.
- 2. Select a country. It does not need to be your homeland.
- 3. Focus on the sphere of fiscal imbalance, specifically on the public debt management and applied fiscal rules in the selected country.
- 4. Prepare short presentation (PPT)/document (DOC, PDF) about the country. Your presentation should more or less cover following issues:
- main objectives of the debt management (both general and operational),
- scope of the debt management,
- characteristics of the debt portfolio (value, structure, interests etc.),
- organizational structure of the debt management,
- cooperation with fiscal and monetary policy,
- division of responsibilities within the debt management,
- existence of the debt management strategy,
- risk management (which risks and how they are managed),
- fiscal rules (type, when and why they were introduced, who apply them),
- fulfilment of fiscal rules (supervision, punishment when not met, exceptions),
- evaluate the situation in the selected country based on your findings.
- 5. As a source use website of the local ministry of finance/state treasury/debt management office. You can also utilize materials from IMF, OECD, WB or European Commission. There are links to useful materials in the interactive syllabi in the Information system.
- 6. Upload your presentation/document to the Information system to Homework Vaults by Monday 12/12 at the latest. This task may be awarded up to 10 points to the final grading system.
