## Precedent: Ineffective use of video sources

The whole activity should take up to 20 minutes (if you are using audio/video, this can only take up to 5 minutes of the overall time allotted).

- 3 simple steps: Be specific

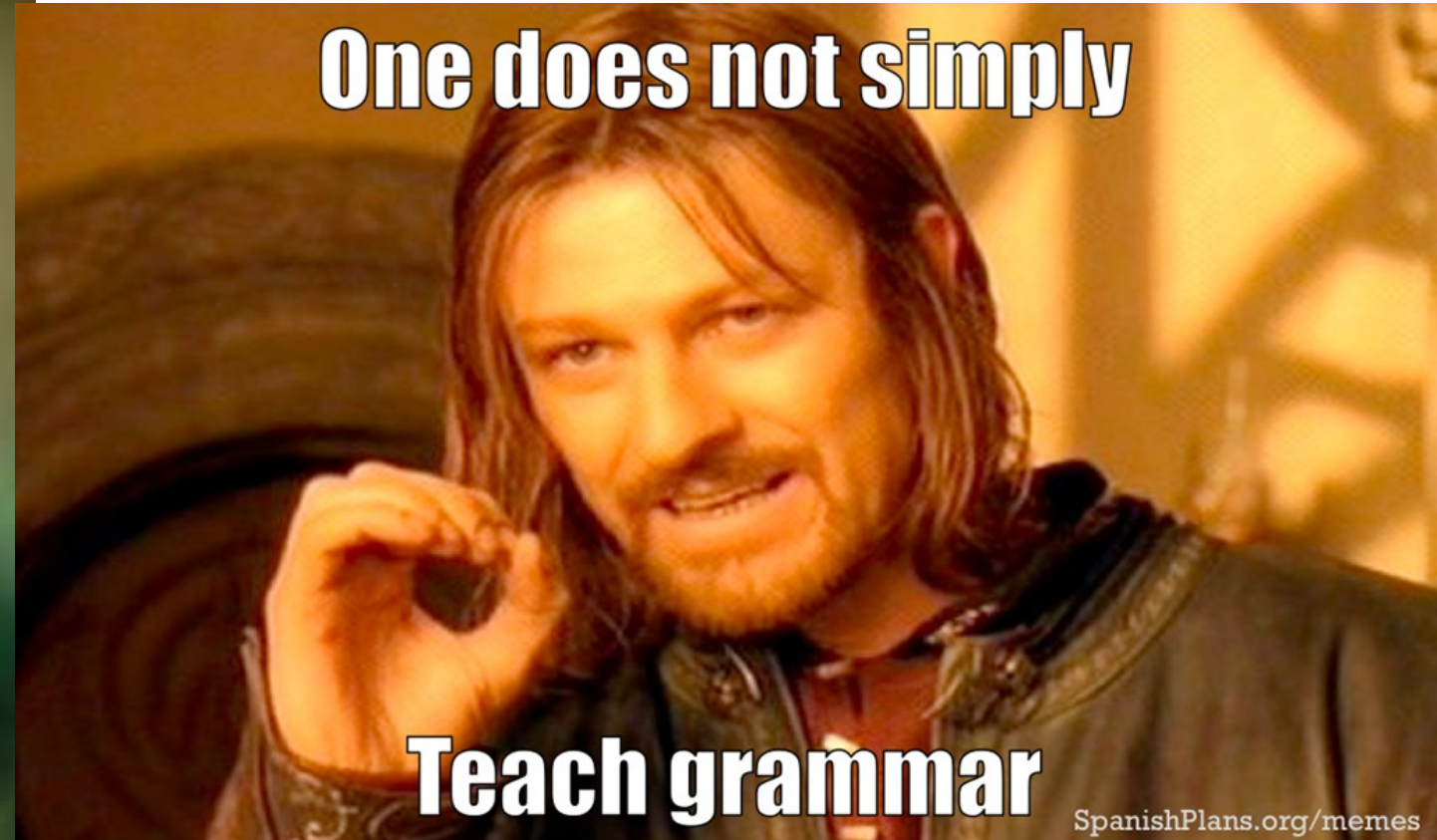
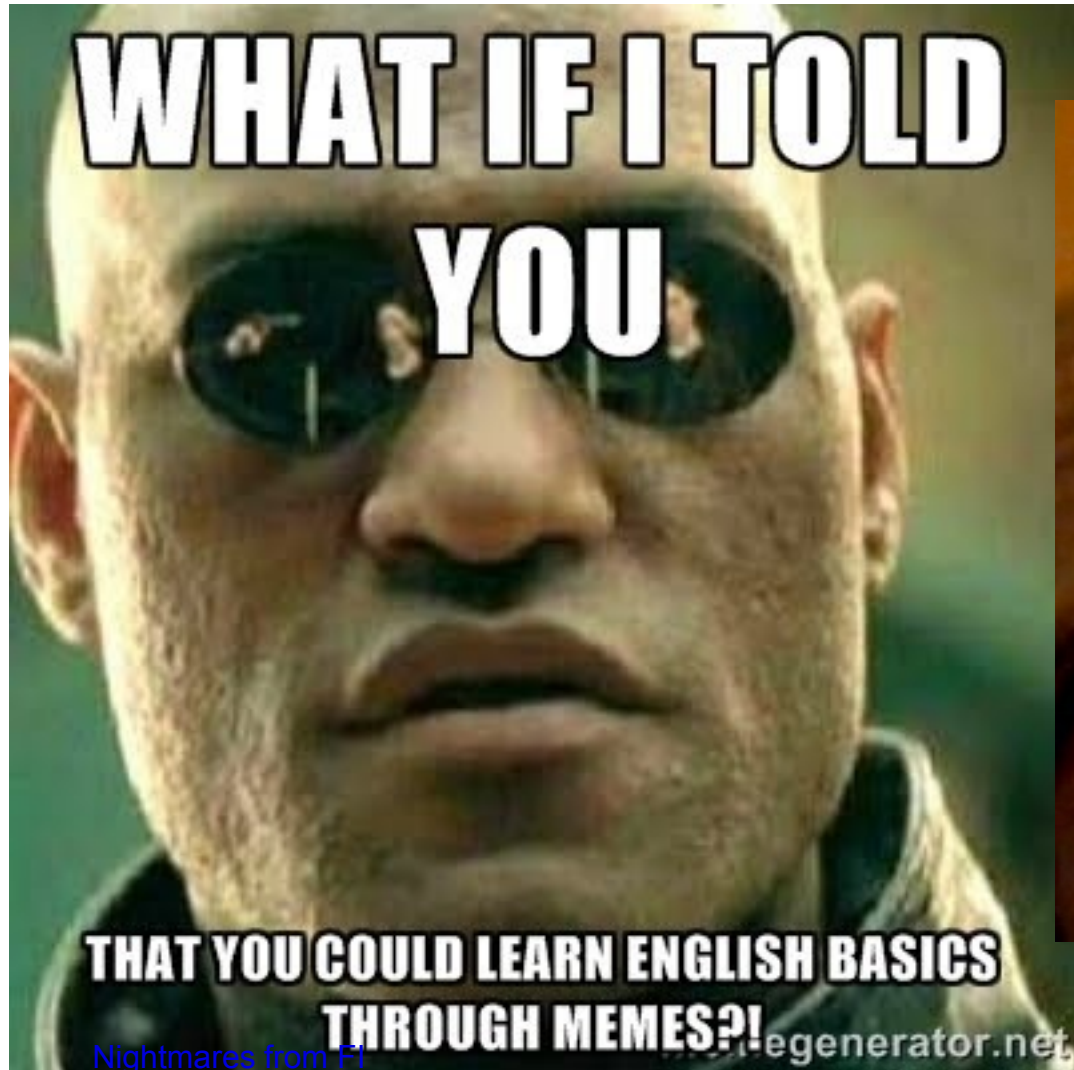

# To Teach or Not to Teach Grammar?



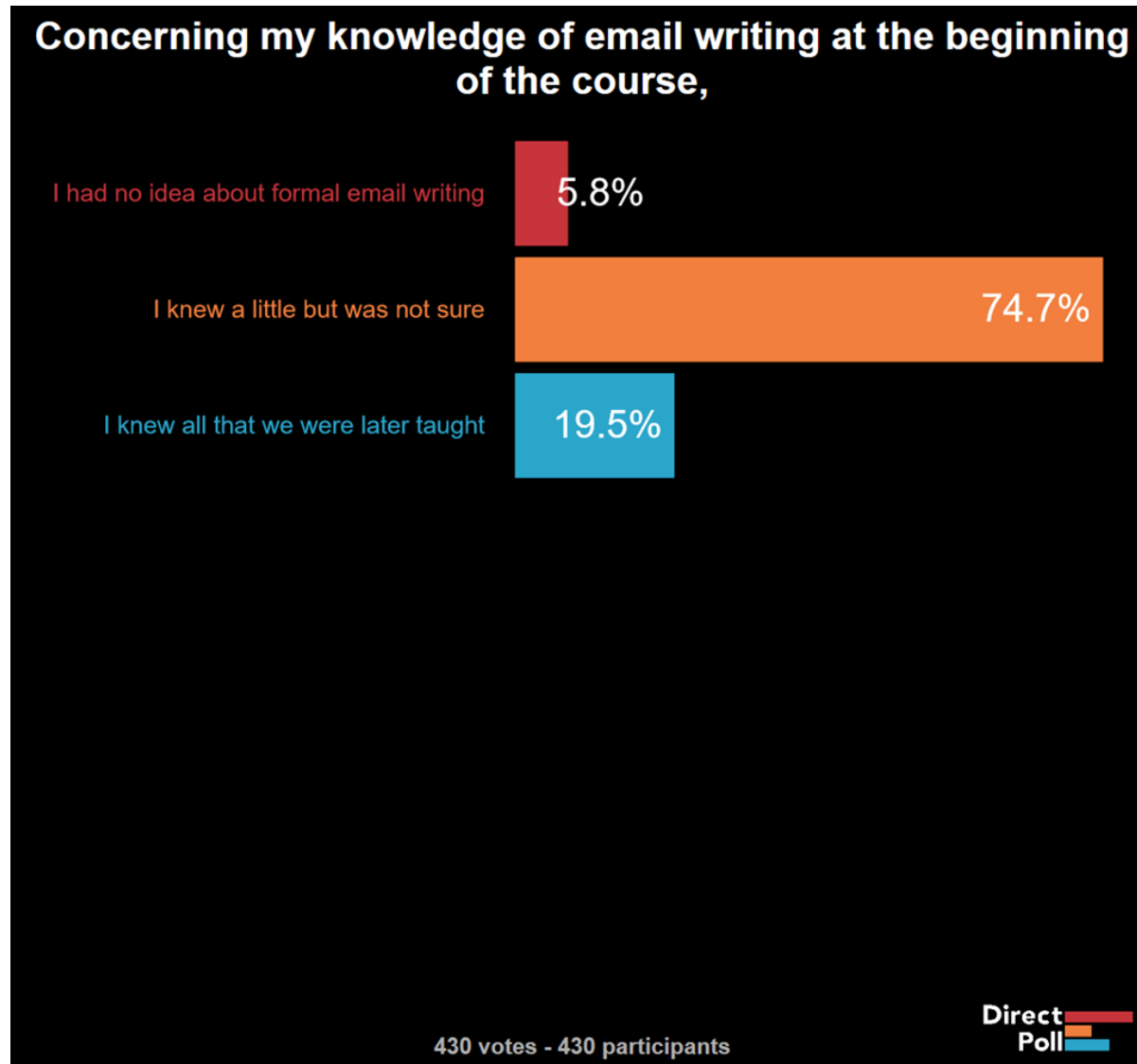
# The Problem of Self-study

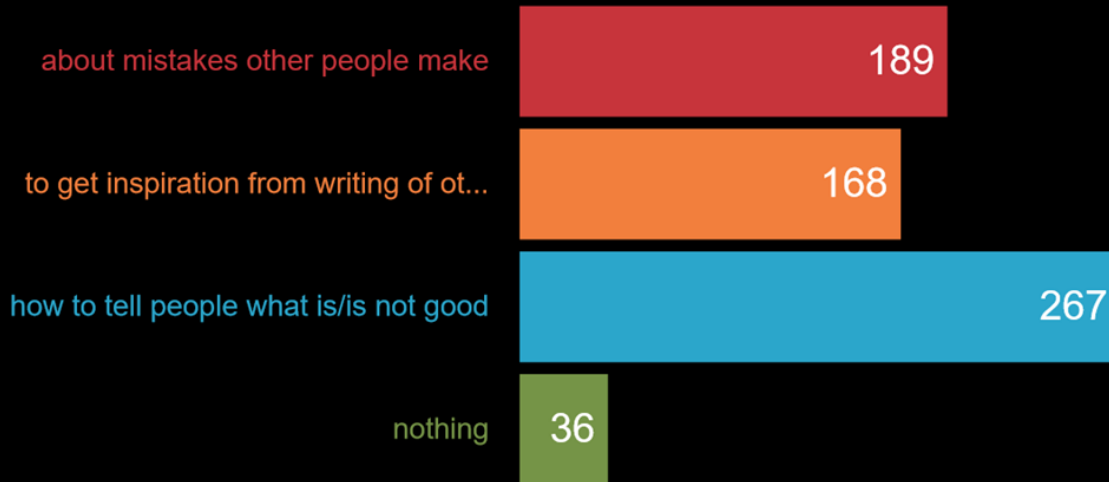


# Writing Email - In-class Email

- Ending the email: “Thanks a lot”

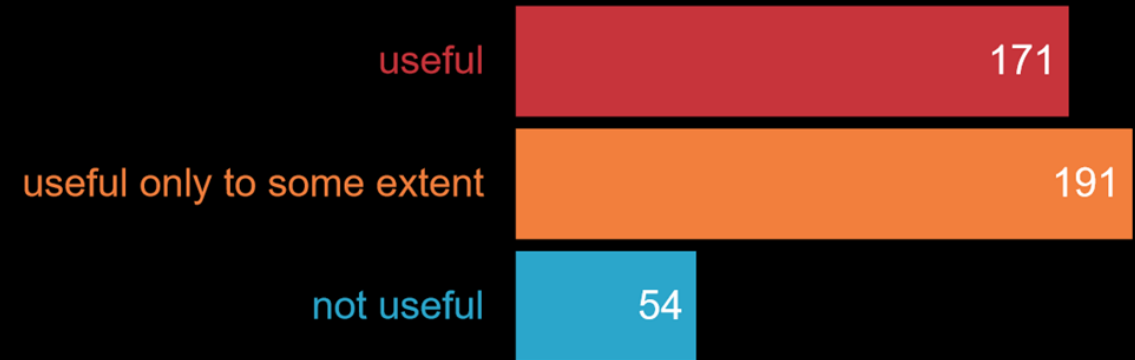
# Online Feedback Data - Selected Answers

## The peer reviews I received were

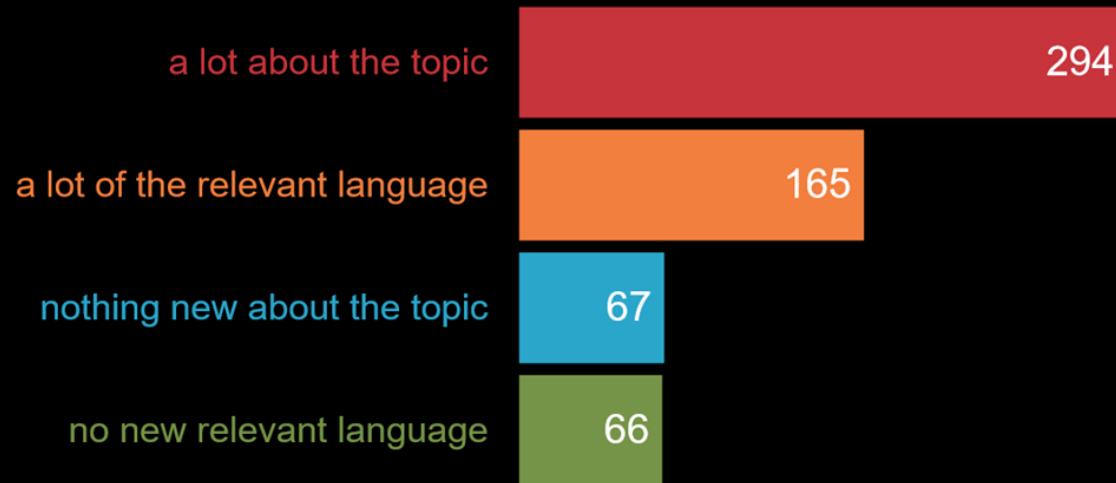

## During peer activity in class I



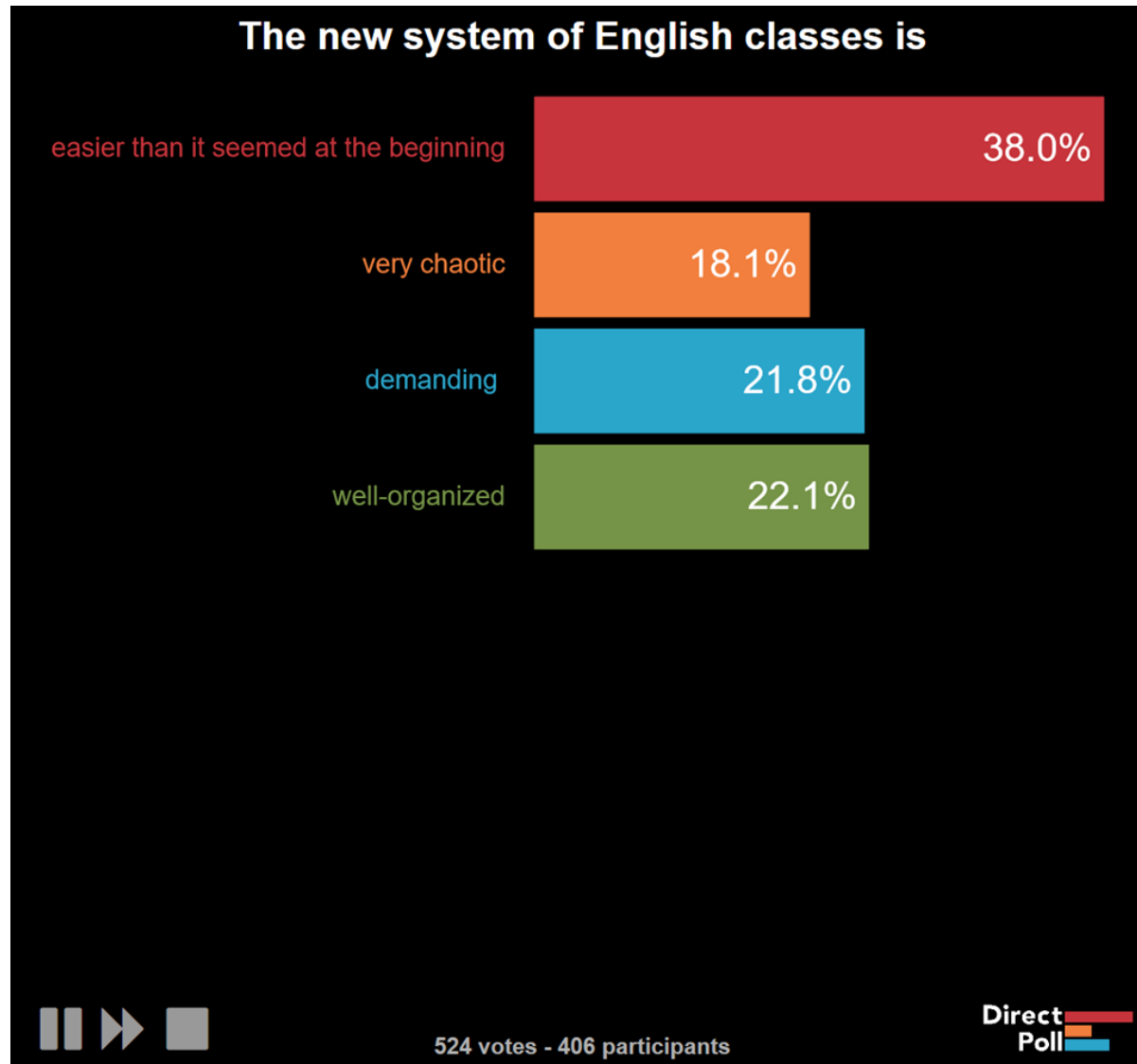
