ACTION RESEARCH ON STUDENT METACOGNITION

3 research cycles: Spring 2019, 2020, 2021

- RQ1: Are students aware of academic/professional skills they practise within a topic-based lesson?
- RQ2: Are students aware of developing legal English knowledge when they practise academic/professional skills?
- RQ3: Can the teacher help students make their learning more effective by enhancing their metacognition about learning?
- methods: questionnaires, individual consultations, feedback
- results: steps supporting student metacognition positively influenced effective learning
