3. List of publications (Annex 3) related to the topic of the thesis (sorted by quartile of the journal's impact factor in the Web of Science (Q1 to Q4) and indicate the corresponding category according to WoS); other key publications and papers accepted for publication (this attachment is not signed – it should be sent only electronically in Word to the assistant of Office for Research and Quality).
4. Current CV in English according to the [template](#), signed by the student.
5. Supervisor's statement on the courses of study, fulfilment of the individual study plan and results of the dissertation (in free form and signed by the supervisor).
6. A statement from the chair of the doctoral board (if the programme being studied has a specialization, a **statement from the chair of the doctoral committee that all requirements of the programme board/programme committee have been met** (in free form and signed by the chair of the doctoral board/doctoral committee).
