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The subject First Aid

- this subject consists of two parts:
 - lectures they are available online in the First aid e-learning in the part
 Video lectures
 - practices organised in the Simulation centre of the Faculty of Medicine of Masaryk University
- completion of the subject First Aid:
 - lectures are completed with a colloquium
 - practices are completed with a credit



First Aid – practice

- the practice consists of 6 units and 1 consultation
- the topics of the practices correspond to the structure of the units of the e-learning:
 - Unit 1 Approach to the unresponsive patient
 - Unit 2 Basic life support and AED in adult
 - Unit 3 Pediatric basic life support, foreign body airway obstruction
 - Unit 4 Management of the bleeding, basics of the bandaging, management of the patient in shock
 - Unit 5 Fractures, immobilization, moving an unresponsive patient
 - Unit 6 Other life-threatening conditions
- the consultation is not obligatory, if you take part in all 6 units

Before the practice:

- go through the e-learning materials and watch the corresponding video lectures
- fill in the pre-test (ROPOTS in IS MUNI, the link is always in the end of the unit in the chapter Unit summary and test)
 - it contains 5 questions
 - one correct answer
 - to pass the test you have to answer 4 from 5 questions correctly
 - unlimited number of attempts
- passing the pre-test is a requirement to attend the practice!



After the practice:

- fill in the post-test (ROPOTS in IS MUNI, the link is always in the end of the unit in the chapter Unit summary and test)
 - you fill in the post-test only once
 - there is no minimum point benchmark defined
- fill in the evaluation form to assess the practice (ROPOTS in IS MUNI, the link is always in the end of the unit in the chapter Unit summary and test)



Credit from the practice

- to complete the subject First Aid practice you have to:
 - complete 6 pre-tests
 - take part in all 6 units in the practices (the consultation is not obligatory, if you take part in all 6 units before)
 - fill in 6 post-tests after the practices
 - fill in 6 evaluation forms after the practices

Colloquium

theoretical

test contains questions from the topics of the practices and also of the video lectures – OSCE (Objective Structured Clinical Examination)

practical

student will solve 1 simulation corresponding with the topics of the practices student will be evaluated by a standardized checklist the course of the practical part is similar to the practices
