1. Registration

BEFORE THE PRACTICE

2. Arrangement of the shifts in the Faculty Hospital in Brno

Each registered student will be contacted by the International Studies Office and will receive the contact details of one supervisor. Students contact the supervisor via e-mail and arrange the summer practice and all necessary details (exact timing, shifts, meeting point at the hospital, etc.) directly with their supervisor.

Note: Please do not delay contacting your supervisor, since their schedule might be busy and it may take some time until you can communicate your preferred timing and find an overlap with their shifts. **E-mail them as soon as you receive their contact details**.
