Aktion Austria – Czech Republic

- Internships for whole months are recommended
- No age limit
- E-application supported by an acceptation letter from concrete teacher from Austria,
 2 recommendation letters from home uiversity, Transcript of Records, Evidence form of applicant
 E-application has to be printied and confimed by Office for Quality
- Scholarships in the amount of 1050 euro per month, exemption from school fee

AIA – Academic Information Agency – Selection Procedure and Quota Scheme

Scholarships based on bilatelar agreement of Czech Republic and other country
 <u>Selection procedure</u>:

- open for applicants from all czech universities
- Albania, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, China, Egypt, Estonia, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary,
 Israel, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, South
 Korea, Spain, Switzerland, Ukraine, Vietnam

Quota scheme:

- Concrete scholarships for selected Czech universities
- China, Croatia, Greece, Macedonia, Russia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden

BTH – Scholarships for Studies in Bavaria

- Scholarships for one or two semesters
- Applicant has to be up to 35 years of age
- Proof of English or German language knowledge on the level of C1
- Grant is 735 Euro per month for one year
- Criteria: Motivation letter + practical experience from other internships + participation in conferences + recommendation letter from supervisor + acceptance letter from foreign institution + concrete cooperation with foreign institution (not necessary)
- Call for applicants 1.12.2022

- Scholarships for one month

15 December for internships in whole academic year

30 September for internships in Summer and Autumn

SPECIAL GRANT FOR SHORT-TERM PLACEMENTS

Program for internships that cannot be supported by any other mobility programs mentioned before.

Two types of scholarships – Study placements + Traineeships

- Internship can be held in any country abroad.
- Internship for 30 days
- Grant in the amount of 10 000,- CZK per month

Call for applicants:

June + September

FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM TO SUPPORT Ph.D. STUDENTS ON THEIR INTERNSHIPS ABROAD

- Financial support in the amount of 25 000,- CZK per month
- E-application via IS (as any other general e-application in IS)
- Attached document proving the readiness of the foreign institution to accept student for the internship (typically a confirmation email from the foreign institution).
- The document signed by supervisor as an expression of agreement with students' internship, and signed by the head of the home institution proving agreement with student's absence
- The scholarship awarded only if the student duly registers his/her internship in IS and uploads a document on the internship (Training Agreement or Learning Agreement for the Traineeship) signed by all parties.
