# THE FACULTY OF ARTS OF MASARYK UNIVERSITY DEAN'S AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING STUDENT THESIS 

Section 1<br>Subject of regulation

This directive regulates the granting of the Faculty of Arts of Masaryk University ("FF MU") Dean's Award.

## Section 2

FF MU Dean's Award

1. The FF MU Dean announces a competition for the FF MU Dean's Award (hereinafter referred to as the "Award") for an outstanding thesis in Bachelor's and Master's studies, and a doctoral thesis in doctoral studies.
2. The Award is intended for students of Bachelor's, Master's and doctoral degree programmes at the FF MU.
3. At the same time as announcing the competition for the Award, the Dean shall set a deadline for accepting proposals.
4. Together with the announcement, the Dean shall determine the period for which the Award is granted.
5. The proposal may be submitted by the Vice-Dean or the head of the unit where the nominee is a student, or the supervisor of a doctoral student. The proposal must include an expert evaluation of the thesis.
6. The Award may be granted to a single applicant or several. The Award need not necessarily be granted.
7. The Dean appoints a board of at least three members to review individual proposals and submit a recommendation for the Award to the Dean.
8. Each of the winners receives a diploma and a financial bonus. The amount of the financial bonus is determined by the Dean.

## Section 3

Final provisions

1. Dean's Directive No. 2/2012 of 23 April 2012 is cancelled.
2. The financial requirements shall be governed by the relevant general rules.
3. The Vice-Dean who checks compliance with this Directive and interprets it shall be nominated by the Dean.
4. This Directive comes into force and effect on the date of signing by the Dean of the faculty.
