 Sweden and Finland have the same model with cost-free meals in school.

• Free of charge, regardless of parents income.



Free public school meals in Sweden – How does it work?



 Legal requirements - Cost-free and nutritious school meals to all children in compulsory school National Educational Act - SFS 2010:800 10 kap. Grundskolan

National Food Agency (Livsmedelsverket) – recommendations



- Budget Every municipality sets their own budget (ca. 1,5 €/student/meal)
- Challenges: Recruitment of cooks and chefs, procurement (local food),
 higher demands (quality and diet demands), refugees and multicultural

From "School food" to "School meals"




• The big picture is more importan than individual nutrients in food

- a holistic approach to school meal quality

- Web-based, free-of-charge
- Validated
- Easy to use
 - A school representative (often the kitchen manager) answers questions
 - Pupils and staff can also be surveyed
- Feedback
 - Instantaneous
 - includes suggestions for improvements



SkolmatSverige has multiple goals

- To help schools evaluate and improve meal quality
- To monitor the effect of a new school meal policy from 2011
- To enable discussions on school food to be evidence-based
- To build up a unique database for research

We can see that meal quality has improved even since 2012

We can see that schools that use the tool improve their quality







Integrated school meals

- generates food enjoyment, inspiration and relaxation
- can be a bearer of culture and an icebreaker
- a socio-economic equalizer and an educational resource IF you make the most out of it – together with teachers and schools
