Dg. criteria for social interaction and Categorical system

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- **1.** Use of nonverbal communication for mediation of social interaction
- **2. Sharing** of activities, emotions etc. and **relationships with peers**
- 3. Social and emotional recognition of others
- 4. Searching consolation of others when stressed or sad or giving consolation to others in the same conditions
