

Commentary on the Announcement of the FF MU Dean's Award for the Development of Foreign Cooperation of the Faculty

The FF MU (Faculty of Arts, Masaryk University) Dean's Award for the Development of Foreign Cooperation of the Faculty complements the existing awards - the FF MU Dean's Award for Outstanding Doctoral Thesis, the FF MU Dean's Award for Outstanding Creative Activity, and the FF MU Dean's Award for Popularization of Humanities and Social Sciences.
