

Dean's Directive No. 1/2016

**SCHOLARSHIP FOR AVERTING THE DIFFICULT LIFE SITUATIONS
OF FA MU STUDENTS**

Section 1

Subject of regulation

This directive sets out the rules for awarding scholarships to students enrolled in Bachelor's or Master's degree studies at the Faculty of Arts of Masaryk University (FA MU).

Section 2

Purpose of the scholarship programme

The purpose of this scholarship is to alleviate particularly difficult life situations of FA MU students that have arisen through no fault of the student.

Section 3

Conditions for awarding the scholarship

To be eligible for the scholarship, the student, i.e. applicant, must meet all of the following conditions:

- a) proves by confirmation from the relevant state social support office or other documents that the total net income of the household in which they live does not exceed twice the amount of the household subsistence minimum (according to Act No. 110/2006 Coll. on the subsistence minimum);
- b) must not have exceeded the standard period of study in any of their active studies at the FA at the time of application;
- c) is not in the process of terminating their studies in any of their active studies at the FA;
- d) does not receive a bursary from a programme announced by the MU Rector's Office.

Section 4

Sources of funding, frequency and amount of scholarships, eligibility

- a) The source of the scholarship is the faculty's Scholarship Fund.
- b) The amount of scholarship awarded depends on the documented seriousness of the student's life situation, the Dean's discretion, and the status of the Scholarship Fund.
- c) A student may submit no more than one application for this scholarship during one academic year.
- d) Application for a scholarship does not confer entitlement to the award of a scholarship.

Section 5

Final Provisions

- a) The Dean of the FA MU may delegate the handling of this scholarship to one of the Vice-Deans.
- b) This directive shall enter into effect on the date of its announcement.
