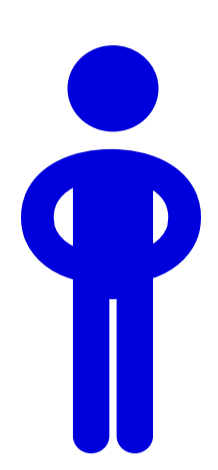

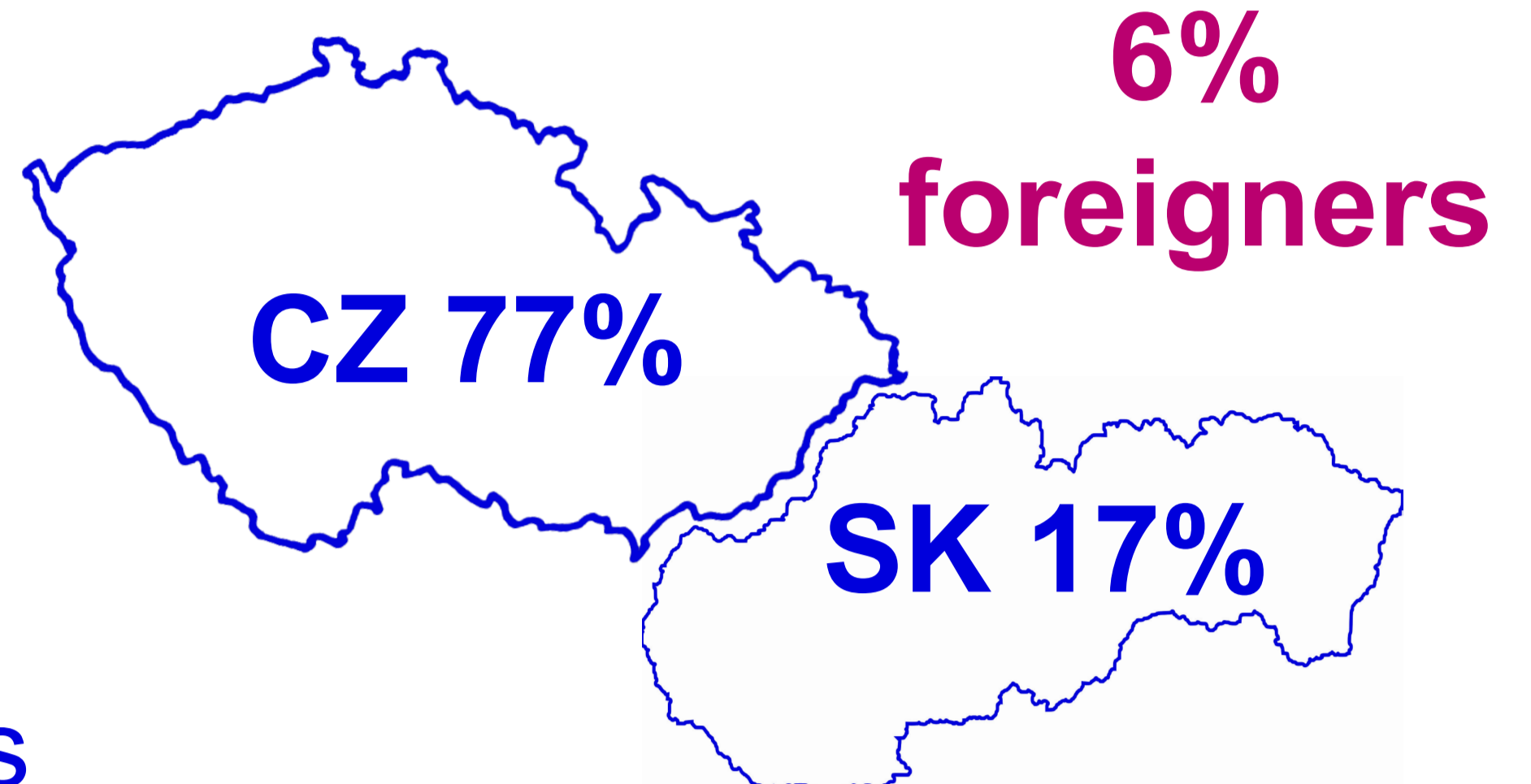
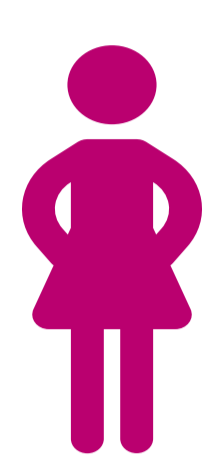
ADMISSION PROCEDURE 2022/2023

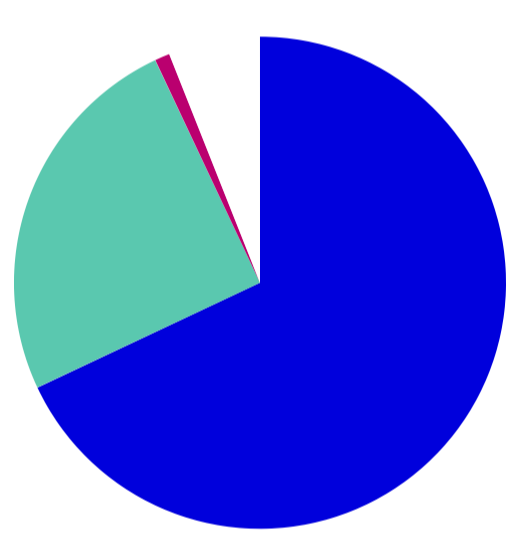

MU APPLICANTS SURVEY RESULTS

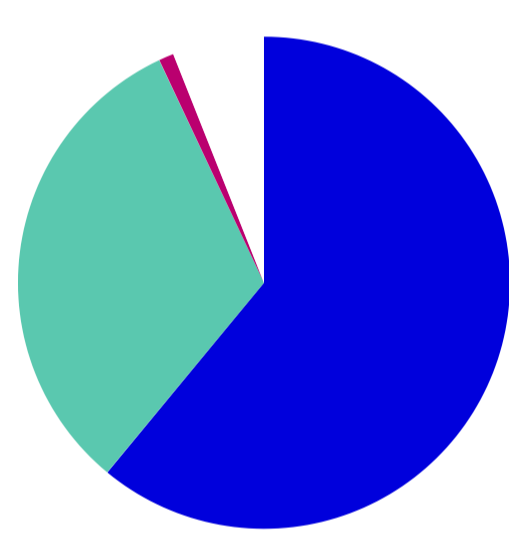
The survey was addressed to 24,557 people with submitted e-application to MU to Bachelor's and long-cycle Master's programmes (in Czech). A total of **3,860 respondents** completed the questionnaire, which represents a **16% response rate**.

The strengths of MU compared to other universities:

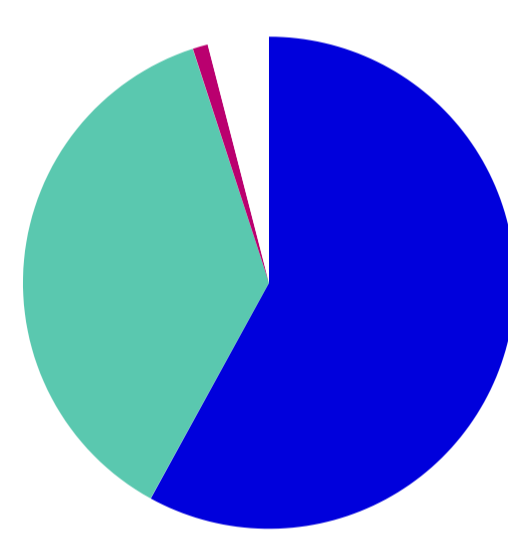
Top five criteria, 55–68% of respondents indicate "better at MU"



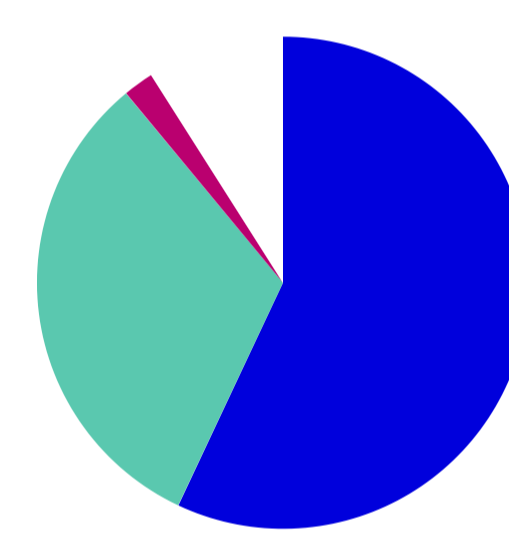
Prestige of the university



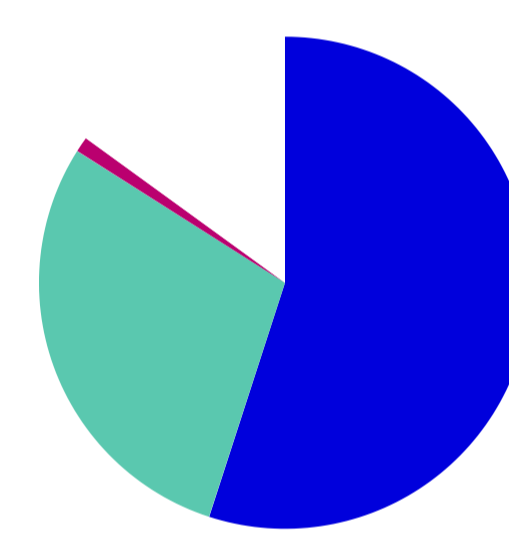
Study programmes
