
# GRADUATES WHO DID NOT APPLY FOR STUDIES AT MASARYK UNIVERSITY

The survey addressed secondary-school graduates who did not apply to Masaryk University in 2023. The presented data is based on 342 completed questionnaires from respondents from the Czech and Slovak Republics.

### Attitude towards future university studies

74% of students are motivated to go to university. They are looking forward to studying, they want to graduate from university.

26% of students are not motivated – they are not confident about their studies or they will "just give it a try".



#### Admission procedure as a decision-making criterion

42% of graduates take into account whether they will be admitted to university without taking the entrance exam.

10% of graduates take into account the number of admitted students.
