

Steps to write a research proposal

TITLE 01 The title of your proposal should be concise and clear to clearly indicate your research question. **ABSTRACT** 02 Include your research question, hypothesis, methodology and findings in the abstract of your proposal. INTRODUCTION 03 Introduction should include the purpose of research, background information significance of your study. LITERATURE REVIEW 04Conduct a detailed literature review to understand the topic and create a clear research question.
