### **Dealing with questions**

I'm actually coming to that point later in my talk.
```

## **Dealing with difficult questions**

```
I'm not sure if I entirely understand your question. Do you mean ...? What I would say is ... I hope that answers your question. I'm afraid I don't have that information at hand, but ...
```
