What is it?

- tool to specify priorities
- which job have to be done earlier than the others

20% Effort

- which rejects must be solved firstly
- which product gives us the biggest revenues
- 80|20 rule ———

How to construct Lorenz Curve and Pareto chart


- list of causes (type of rejects) in %
- table where the most frequent cause is always on the left side of the graph

| Reject | Туре | Importance | Importance (%) | Accumulative (%) |
|--------|--------------|------------|----------------|------------------|

| 1 | Bad size | 10 | 71% | 71 %=71% |
| 2 | Bad material | 3 | 21 % | 92%=71%+21% |
| 3 | Rust | 1 | 8% | 100 %=92%+8% |

Comment 1: 10+3+1=14

Comment 2: 71 % = 10/14; 21%=3/14;.....
