

Few facts

- multinational corporation that designs and manufactures consumer electronics and computer software products.
- established in Cupertino, California on April 1, 1976 and incorporated January 3, 1977, the company was called
 Apple Computer, Inc. for its first 30 years, but dropped the word "Computer" on January 9, 2007
- Apple has about 35,000 employees worldwide and had worldwide annual sales of US\$32.48 billion in its fiscal year ending September 29, 2008.

History

- 1976 Apple I personal
 computer kit established by
 Steve Jobs, Steve Wozniak,
 and Ronald Wayne
- 1977 Apple II introduced at the first West Coast Computer faire





History

 1978 – Steve Jobs began working on the Apple Lisa

 1984 – Macintosh announced by famous TV commercial

- 1989 Macintosh Portable Apple's first "portable" Macintosh computer
- 1991 PowerBook: the modern form and ergonomic layout of the laptop computer

The rainbow "bitten" logo, used from late 1976 until replaced in 1998 by monochrome themes.



The monochrome-themed logo maintained the same shaped as the rainbow theme it replaced. It is still used and often appears in various colors on various products, such as packaging and advertisements.
