



The vertical axis of the graph shows total sales in thousands of dollars while the horizontal axis shows the months in a year. The solid line represents sales figures for the East, the dashed line for the West and the dotted line for the South.

In January, sales stood at \$145,000 in the Eastern region. The figures (verb) (adverb) until March when they (verb phrase) at \$160,00 for the current year.
