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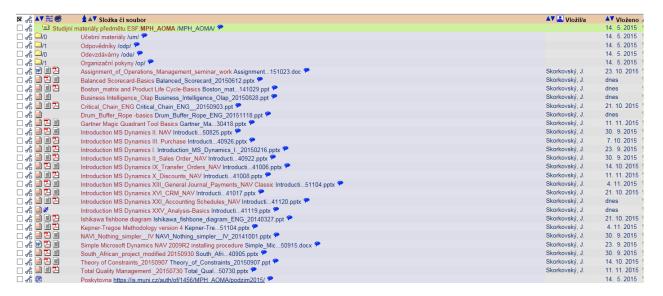
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All questions could be studied with the help of related study materials handed over to students during lessons held in Brno (Autumn-Winter 2015)

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Practice Questions MS Dynamics NAV 2009 R2(Classic version od database)

- Modularity of the ERP systems. What areas can be controlled by ERP MS Dynamics NAV. (TS1 resource and NS).
- 2. Main windows (forms) used in ERP and syntax for Debits and *Credits (posted General Ledger Entries)* card window, line window, matrix window (e.g. Item by location from Item cards) header and line window (form and sub-form, which is basic structure for every NAV document (Sales Order, Purchase Order, Credit Note, Contact Card (CRM), Transfer Order,..) (TS1 and TS2 resources and NS). Do not take into consideration creation of the new customer card by use of template (TS2), which was not presented!
- 3. Main tables (Item, Customer and Vendor- basic data field such as balance, Basic unit of measure, Payment condition, Costing methods and so on. You can use Help which can be accessed by key F1 for better and more concise presentation!! (TS1 and TS2 resources and NS).
- 5. Purchase of an item and impacts of F11 (posting) -> item and vendor entries, G/L entries (TS3 and TS4 resources and NS). Create new Purchase Order and show all impacts (Item ledger entries, General Ledger entries and Vendor Ledger Entry!
- 6. Sale of an item and impacts of F11 (posting) -> item and customer entries, G/L entries (TS2 resource and NS). Create new Sales Order and show all impacts (Item ledger entries, General Ledger entries and Customer Ledger Entry!
- 7. Payment of the open entry (*Customer or Vendor*) by use of the Financial Journal and impacts. (*This can be shown in Financial Management area (menu) ->General Ledger->History- >Registers*)! (*TS13 resource*). Show how to get payment from chosen Customer with non-zero Balance on Customer Card. Explain what is the meaning of Open entry!
- 8. All presented discounts (price, % and invoice) and the use of this incentives! What kind of discounts do we have in MS Dynamics NAV? (TS10 resource). Show setup of discount specified by examiner and impact of applied discount in sales lines!
- 9. Contact Card and its profile and use of it. Connection to Customer (Vendor) card. **(TS16 resource).** What is use of profile? How the contact card is connected to Customer? What it is so? What kind
- 10. What is an Opportunity and Sales cycle? (Show from Contact card or Salesperson card) and how to create a new interaction from the contact card (use of wizard) (TS16 resource)? How to see after it is created in MS Dynamics NAV database? Use already created Opportunities, where you can easily access Sales Cycles (see main hotkeys short-hands) (TS24 resource)?
- 11. Transfer Order (*Present to examiner transfer of chosen item from Blue to Red Location*). After Transfer Order will be posted show by use Ctrl-F5 created item entries (TS9 resource)! How many item entries will be created during transfer?
- 12. Analysis examples and Accounting schedule. Start chosen Accounting schedule. Only basic principles (name of the analysis, line template and column template) (TS21 and TS25 resources). Start already created analysis, which can be found in demo database some examples and explain benefits and use of it.
