- Movable resource


Why?



- ▶ founded in 2003 by XenSource, bought in 2007 by Citrix
- 2013 under Linux Foundation as Xen Project
- native hypervisor


ZEN



KVM

- Modular kernel virtualization
- provides user space access to hw virtualization
- started by Qumranet
- 2007 merged into linux kernel

KVM




QEMU

- hosted hypervisor
- provides emulation of hw
- can be used with KVM for hw virtualization

Libvirt

- Common API for hypervisor type abstraction
- supports
- LXC
- KVM/QEMU, Xen, VirtualBox
- VMware ESXi and Workstation
- MS Hyper-V, IBM PowerVM

Libvirt




oVirt

- engine

- VDSM virtual desktop and server manager


OpenStack
