



What is feedback and how to provide it

- Feedback is not about correcting mistakes and editing
- Feedback is providing guidance
- See what the positive and negative features of your fellow student's work are
- Focus only on several key areas
- Start with a positive point and keep your comments balanced
- Be encouraging





Comment on a letter written by a fellow student. In your comments consider the following aspects

- Content (Do you understand the message of the letter?)
- Structure (clear, logical, linking words, ...)
- Style (appropriate, formal, ...)
- Vocabulary (range, accuracy, collocations, ...)
- Grammar (range, accuracy especially word order)
