


Not accurate but not a caricature

- Not a funny/ satirical caricature either
- Utilise the environment, colour palette, and drawing technique, focus on specific parts.....
- and tell a story

Self-portrait of Chen Junde: visible strokes usually focusing on the 'flow of light'








Brian Lewis drew a whole Series of self-portraits on drugs



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


