

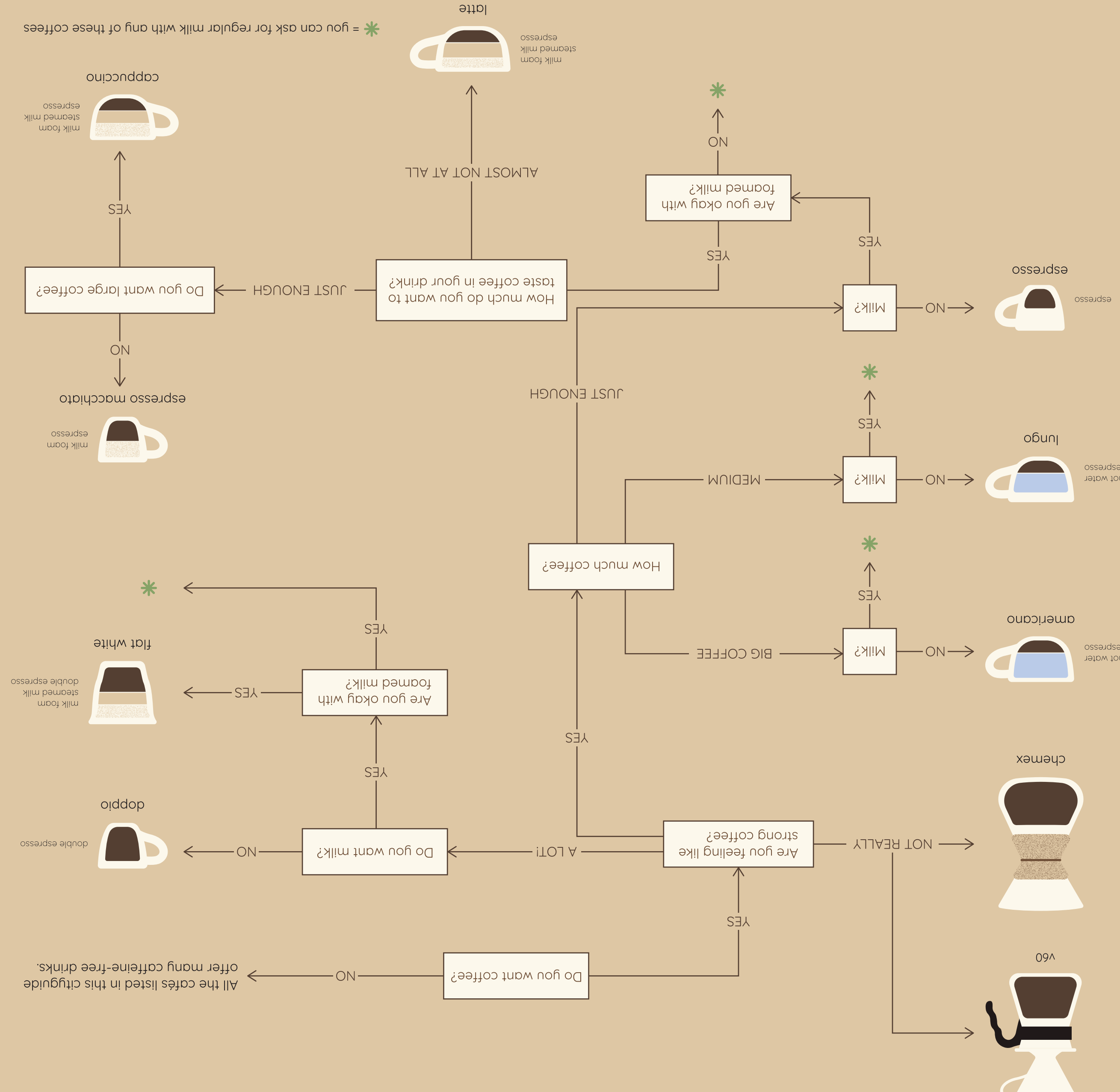


Wanna know something about the history of coffee in Brno?
