### Brno Mosque

The first mosque in the Czech Republic was built in Brno. It is the only func- Difficulty: 6666 tional building of this type in our territory. The construction of the mosque

was accompanied by considerable opposition from a large part of the population. The whole of Brno was flooded with yellow-red posters warning the citizens about building a mosque in the city. People drafted petitions, demonstrated in front of the town hall, and local newspapers and government newsletters dealt with the topic. The Brno city council finally set the conditions that the mosque must not have a minaret, dome and must not be different from the surrounding buildings. Noted that the building is slightly rotated compared to the surrounding buildings, it is oriented towards Mecca.

City quarter Dornych is one of the last witnesses of the former Brno industrial fame. It is a dirty and often depressive place, where now lives the Brno's poorest population. There was also one (more romantic) nickname for this area. Svratka Raceway together with Svitava Raceway created here peculiar genius loci - Dornych was called Little Venice.
