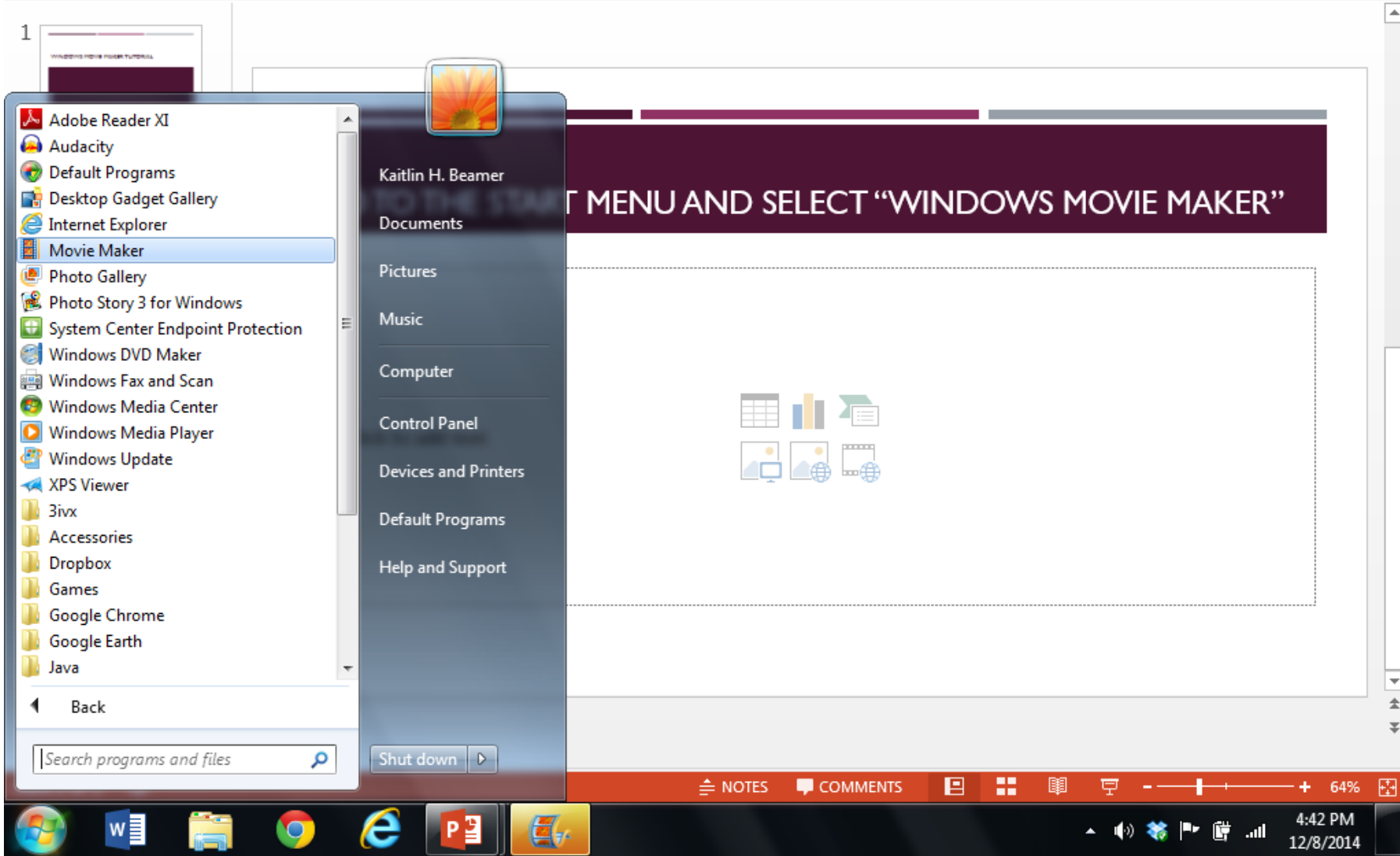
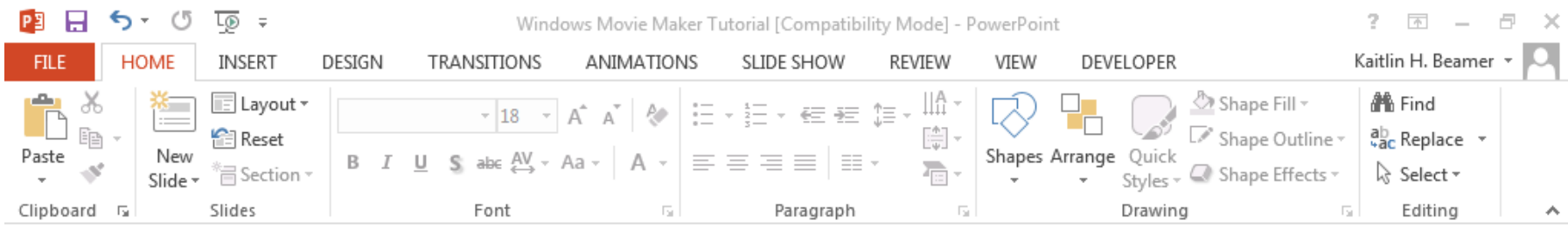


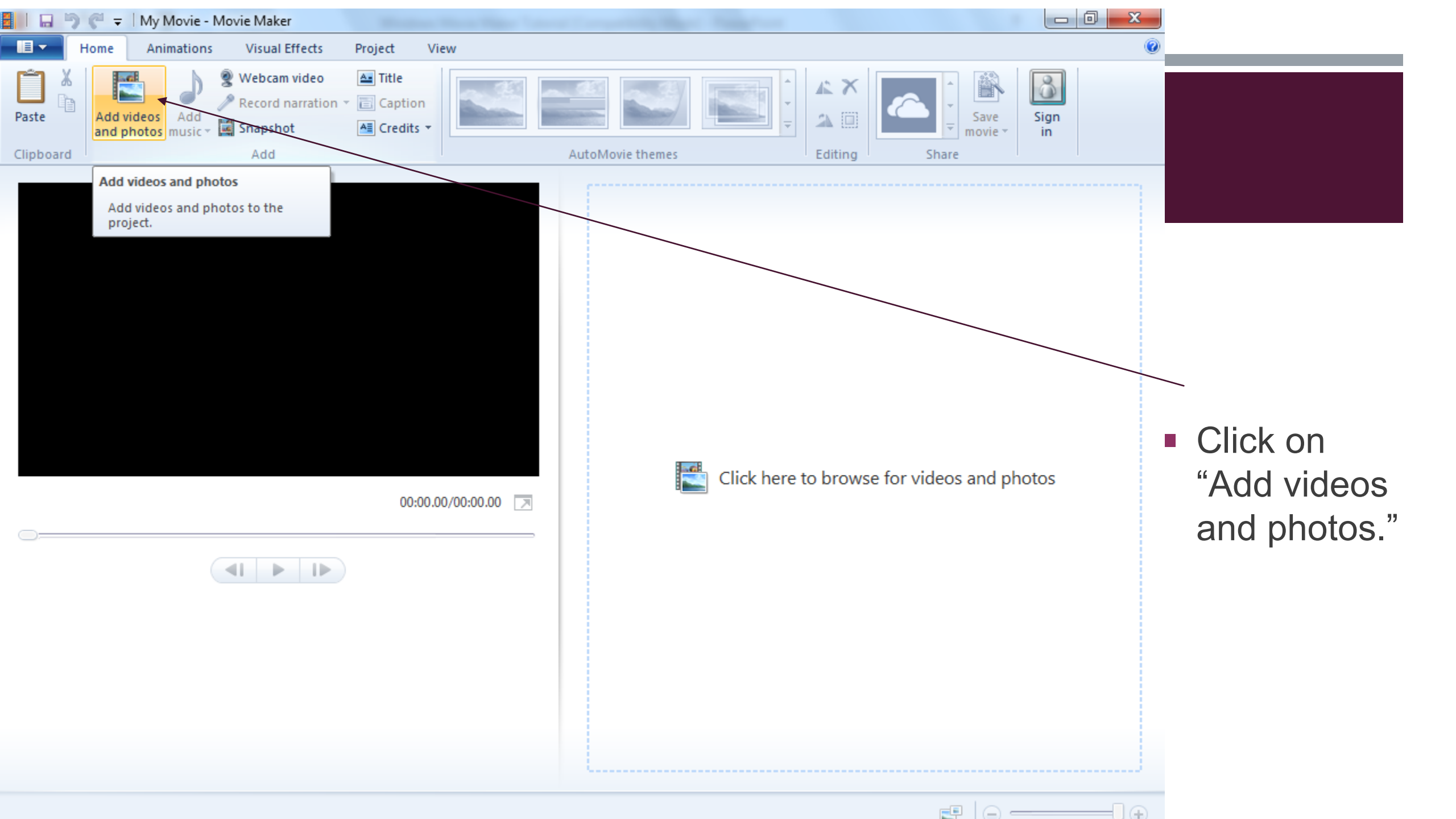


WINDOWS MOVIE MAKER TUTORIAL






- Go to the start menu and select “Windows Movie Maker”

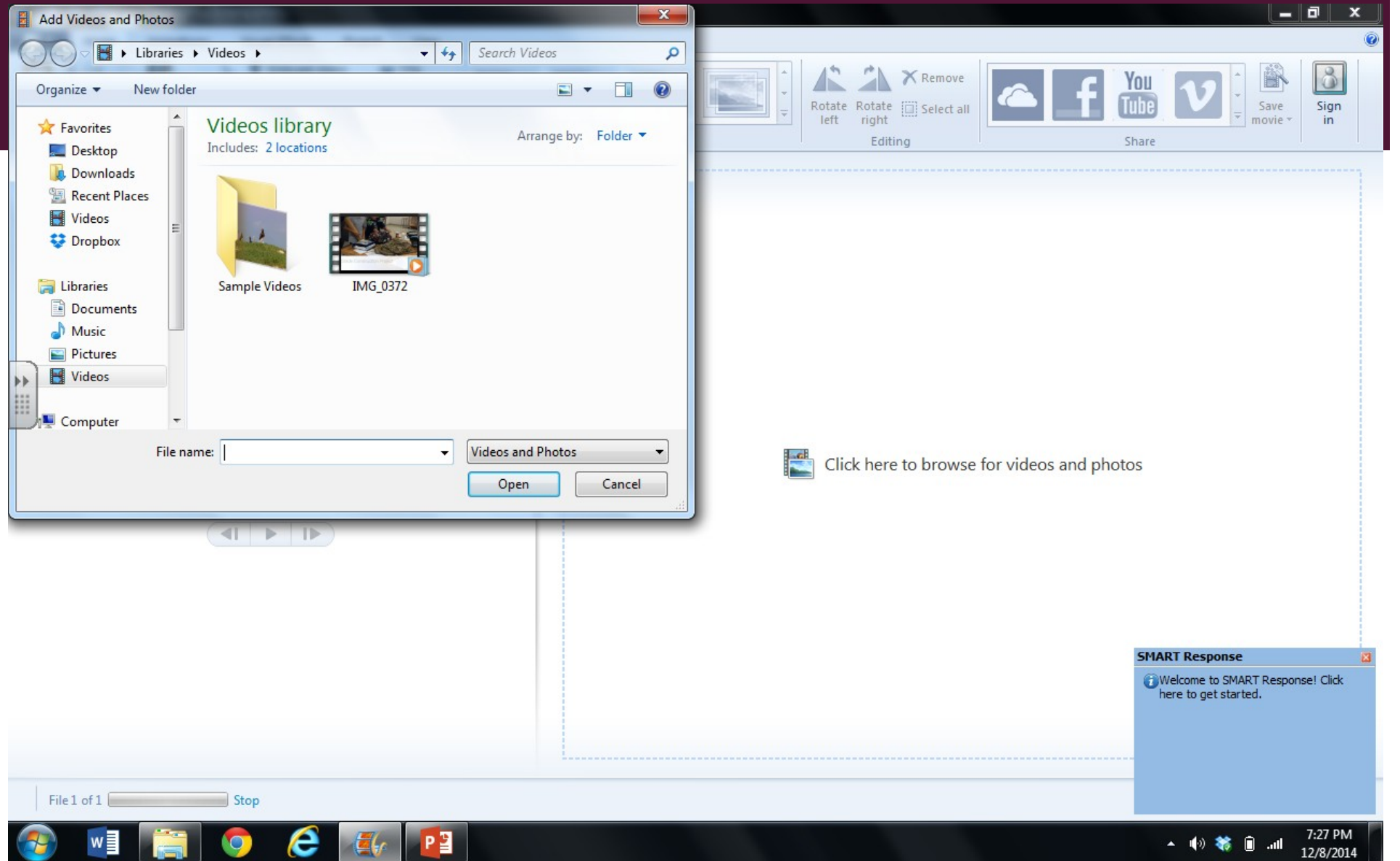


Add videos and photos

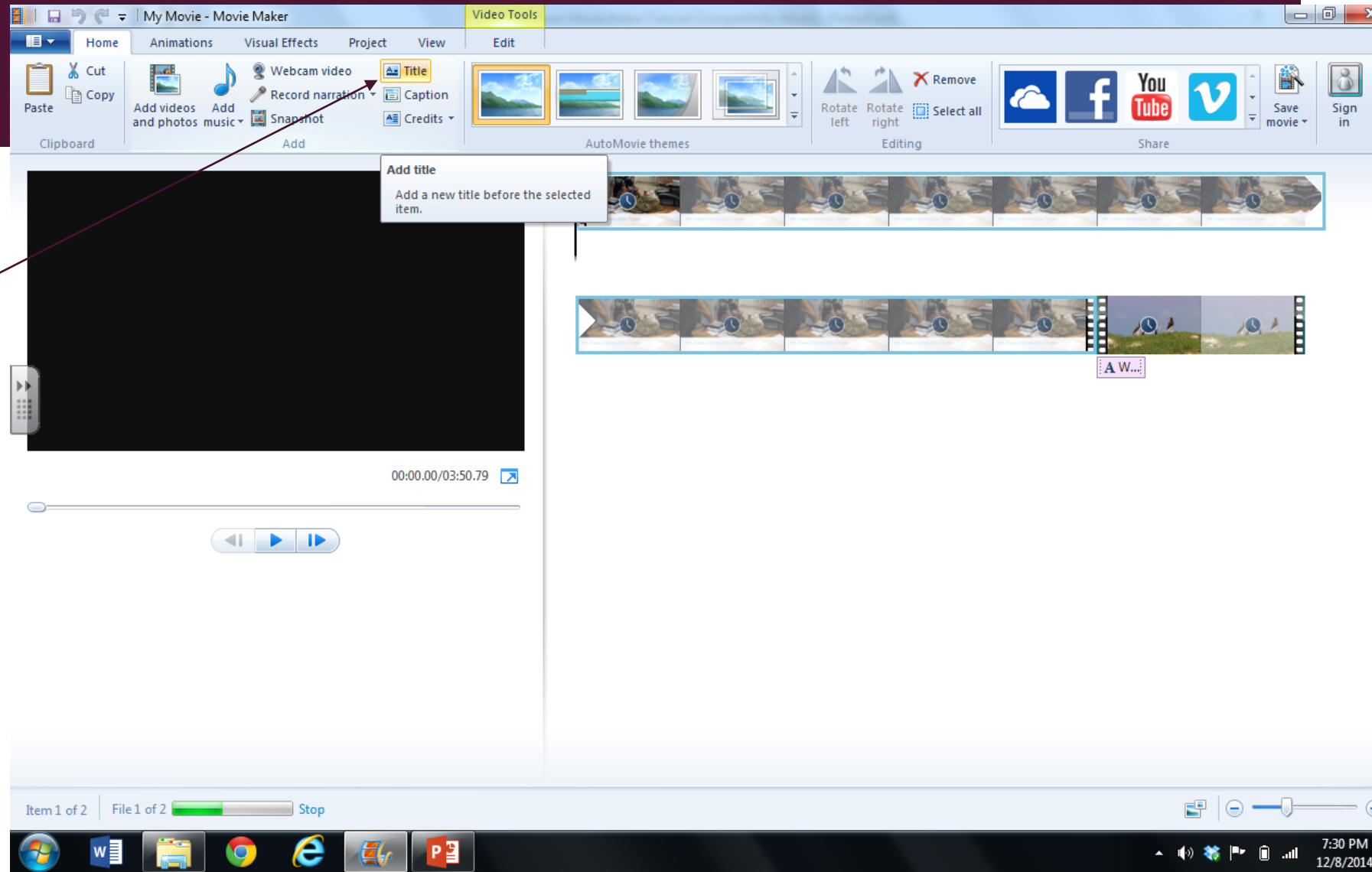
- Click on “Add videos and photos.”

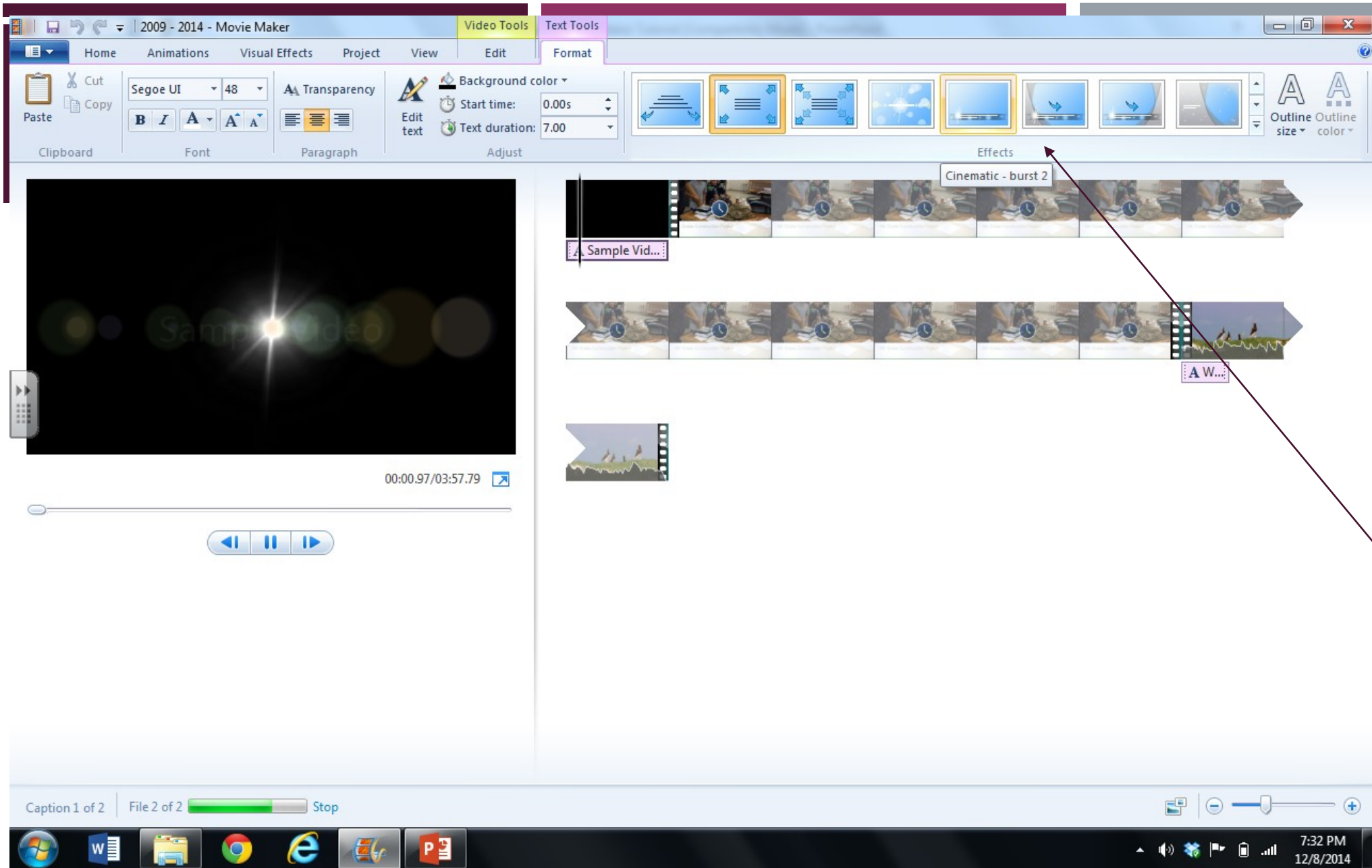
- Choose the video clip(s) you want to use.



ADDING A TITLE

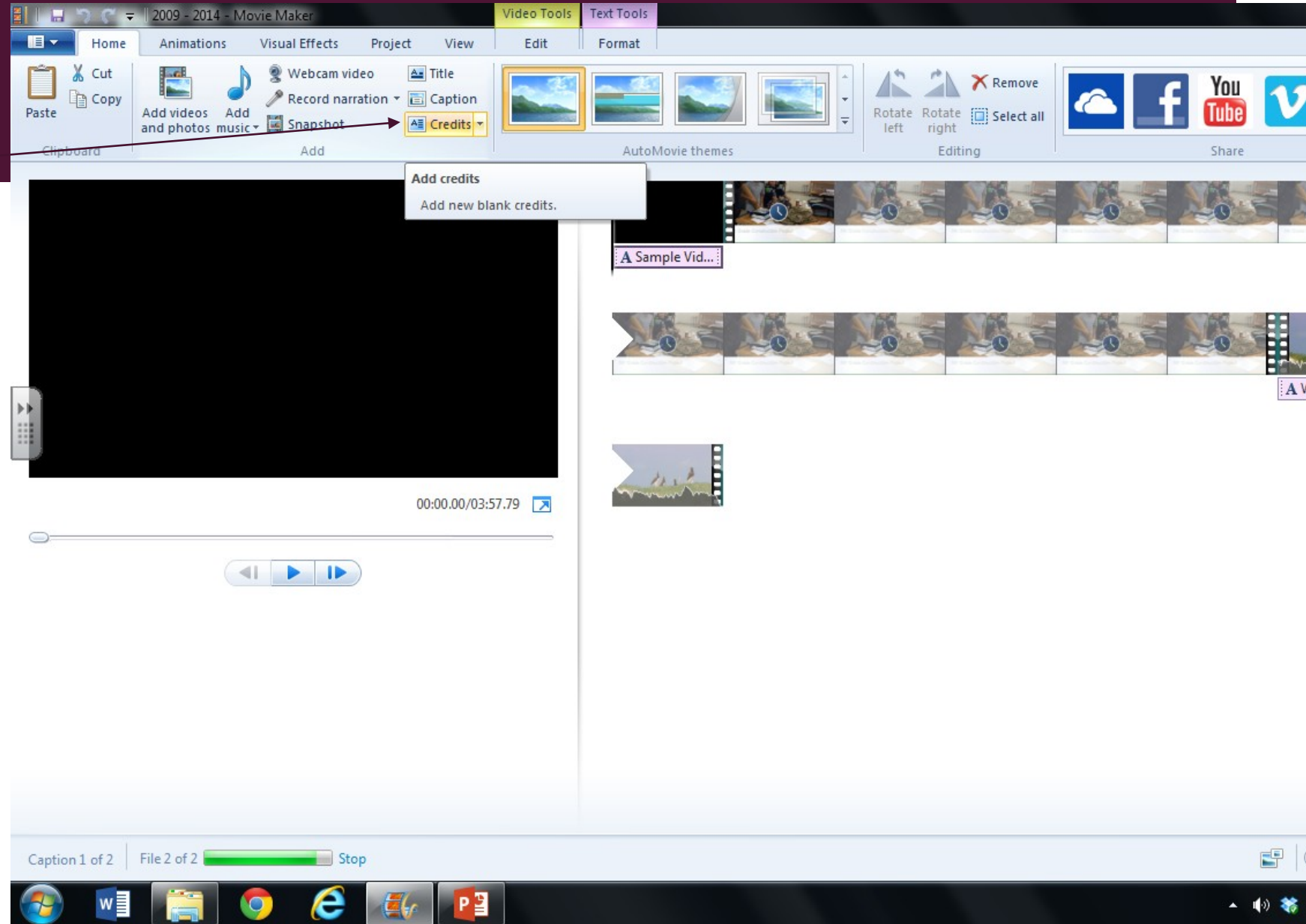
- Select "Title"

- Choose an effect

Clipboard: Paste, Cut, Copy

Font: Segoe UI, 20, Bold, Italic, Underline, Color, Size

Paragraph: Transparency, Bullets, Numbered, Indent

Adjust: Background color, Start time (238.13s), Text duration (6.99)

Effects: 8 effect thumbnails, with the last one highlighted in yellow

Outline: Outline size, Outline color

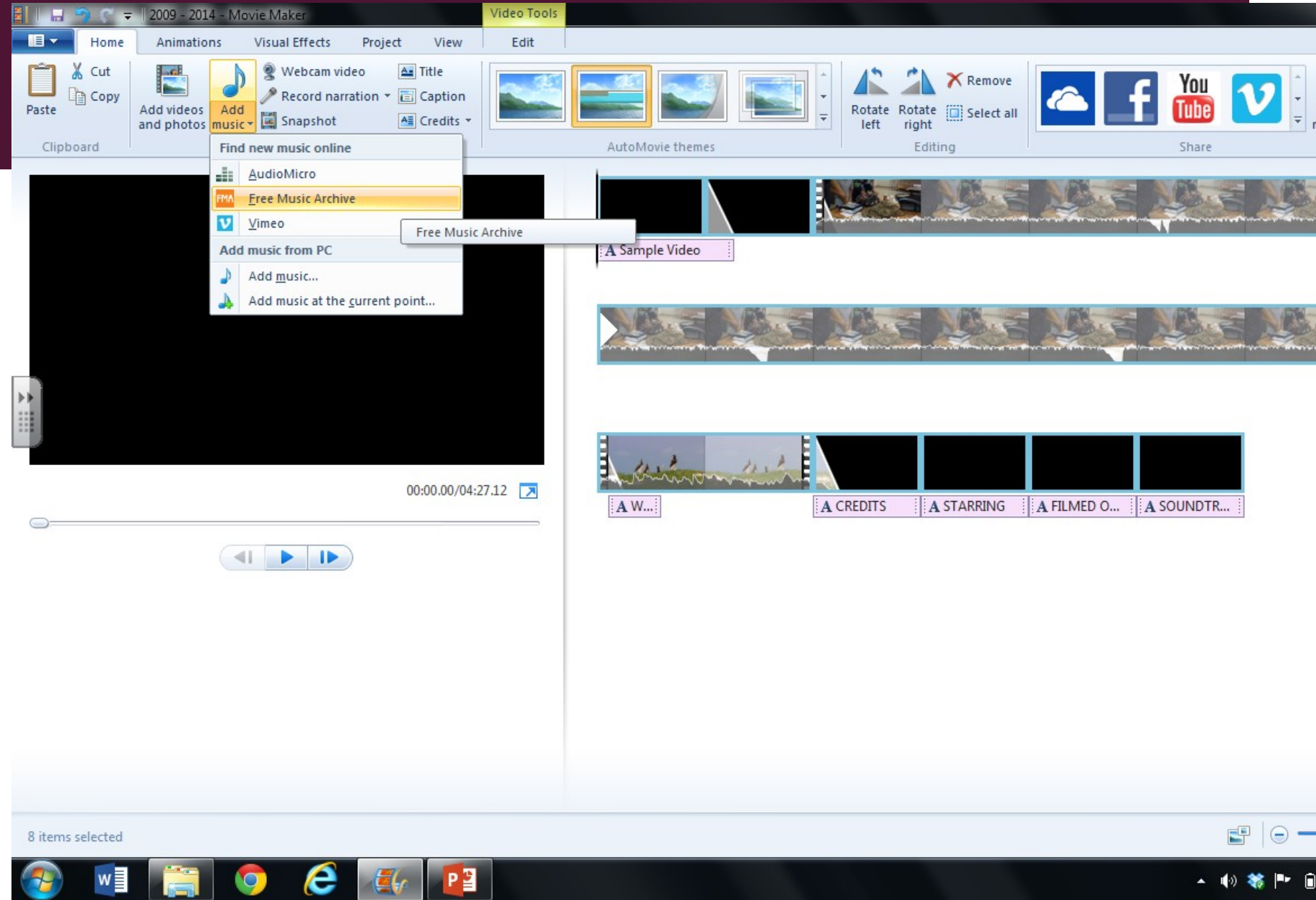

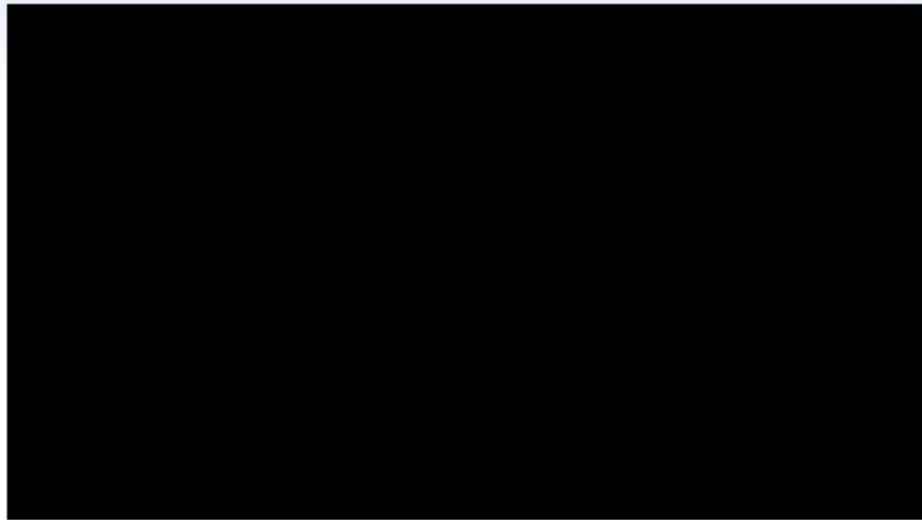
TITLE, CREDITS, CAPTIONS

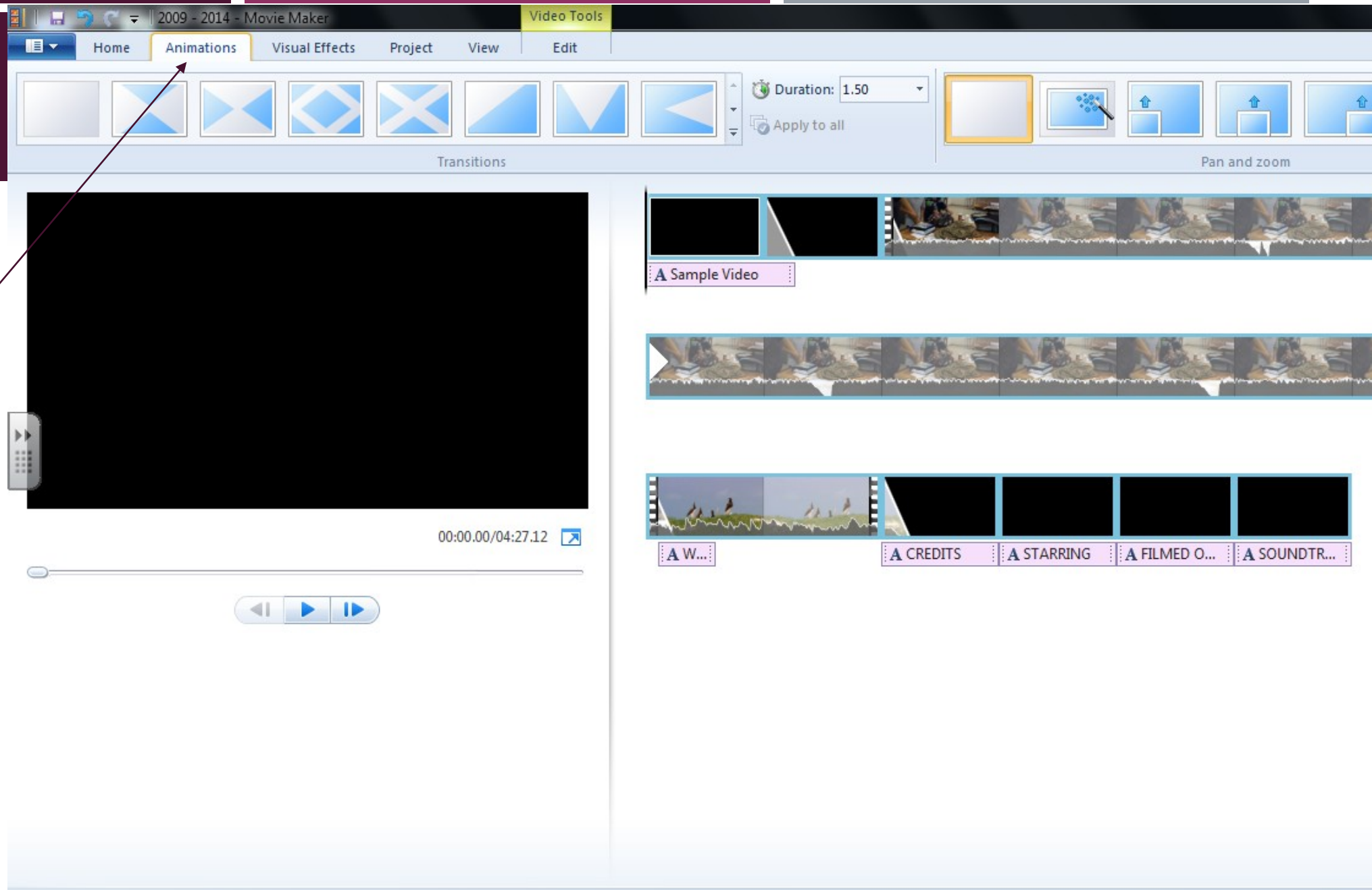

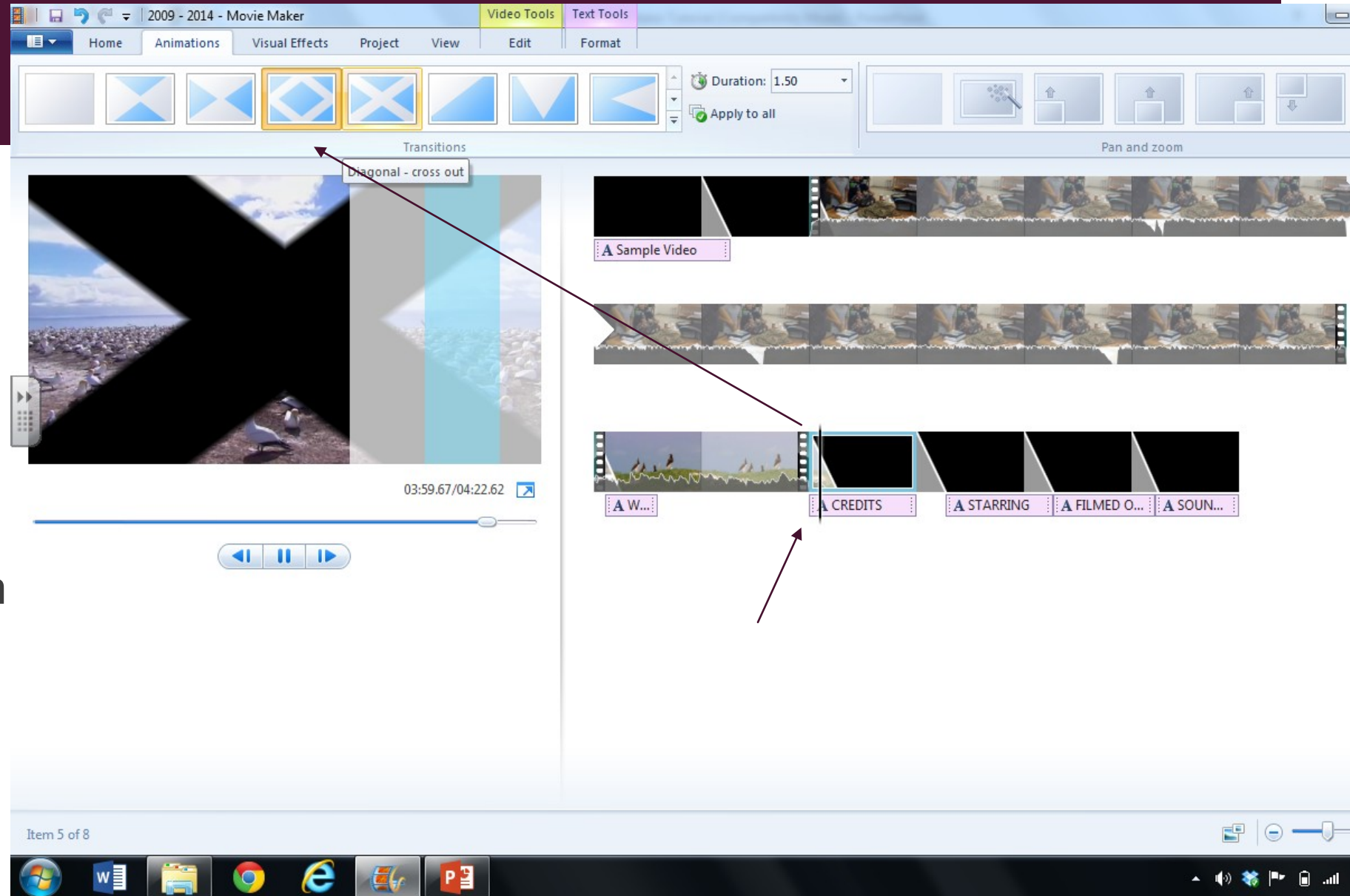

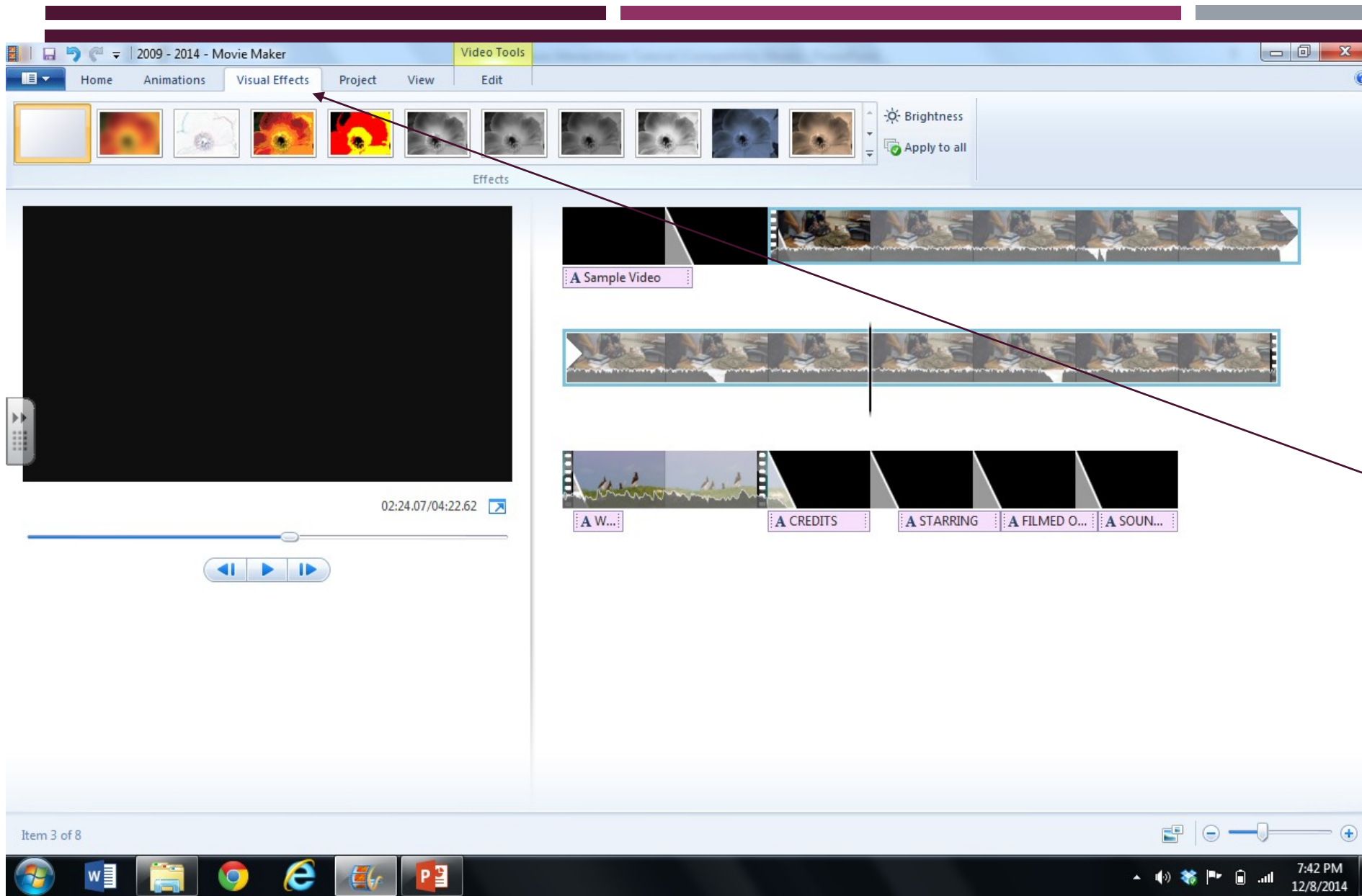

- Adding animations

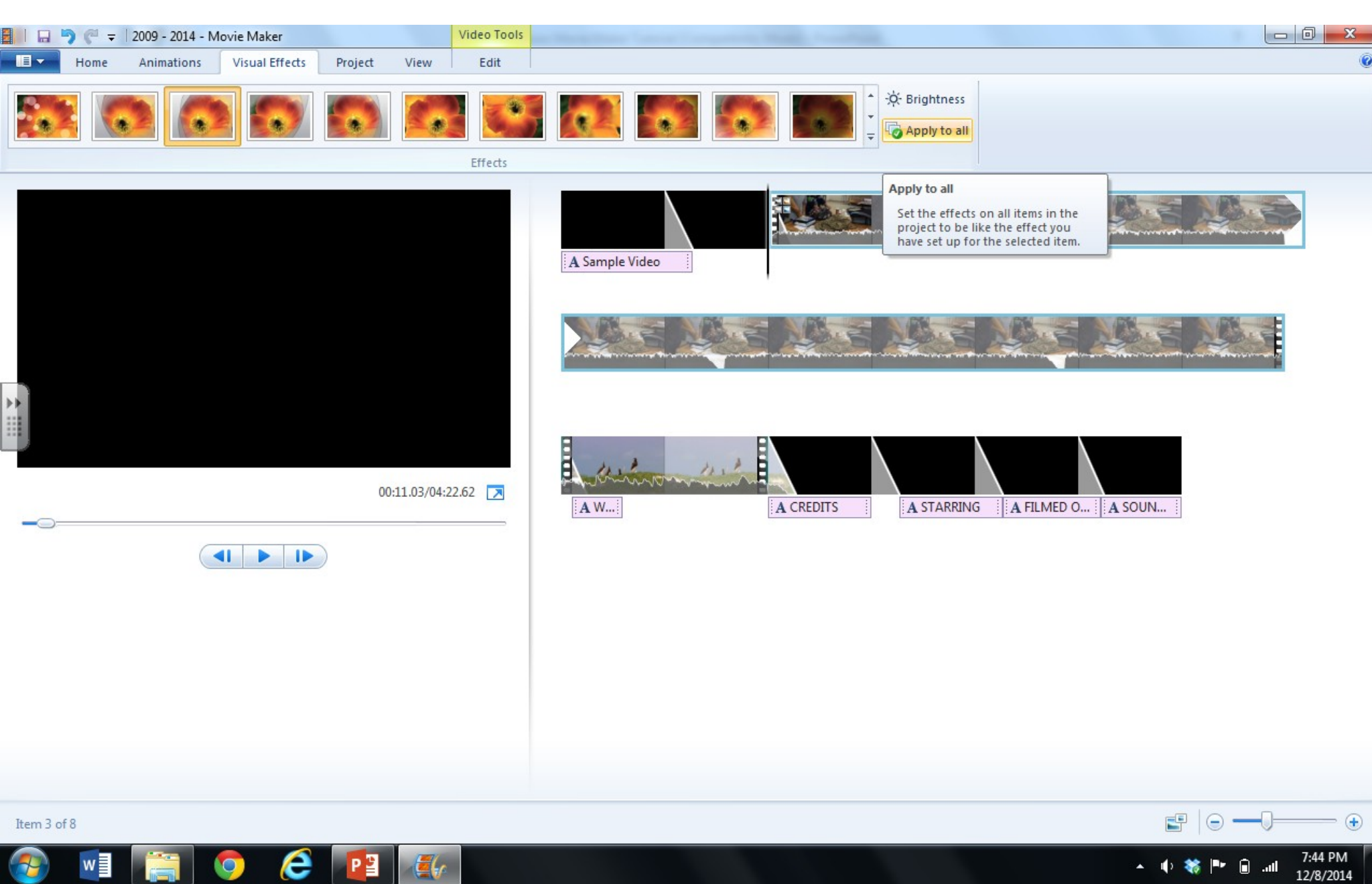


- Select the clip that you want to add a transition to
- Pick your transition



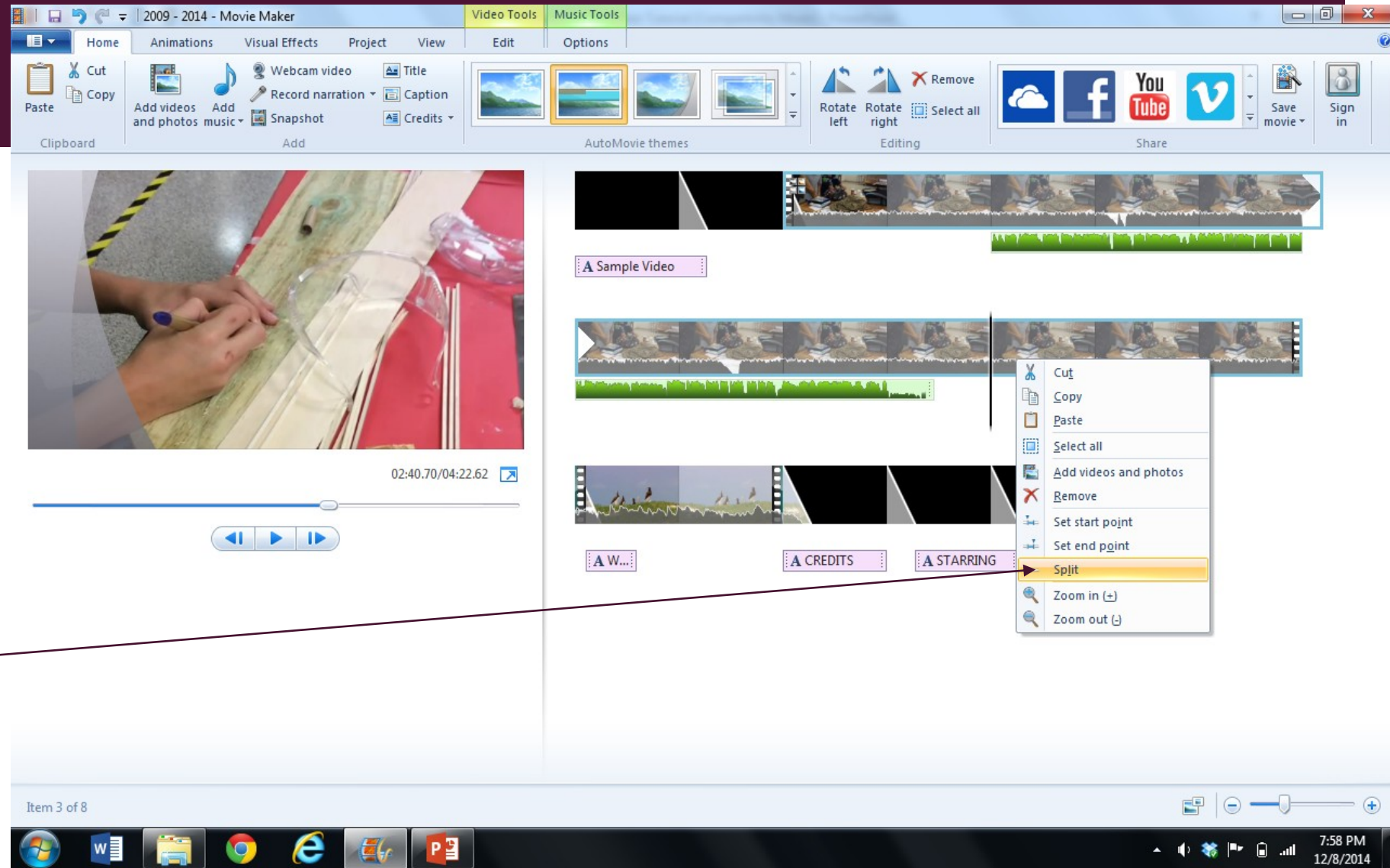


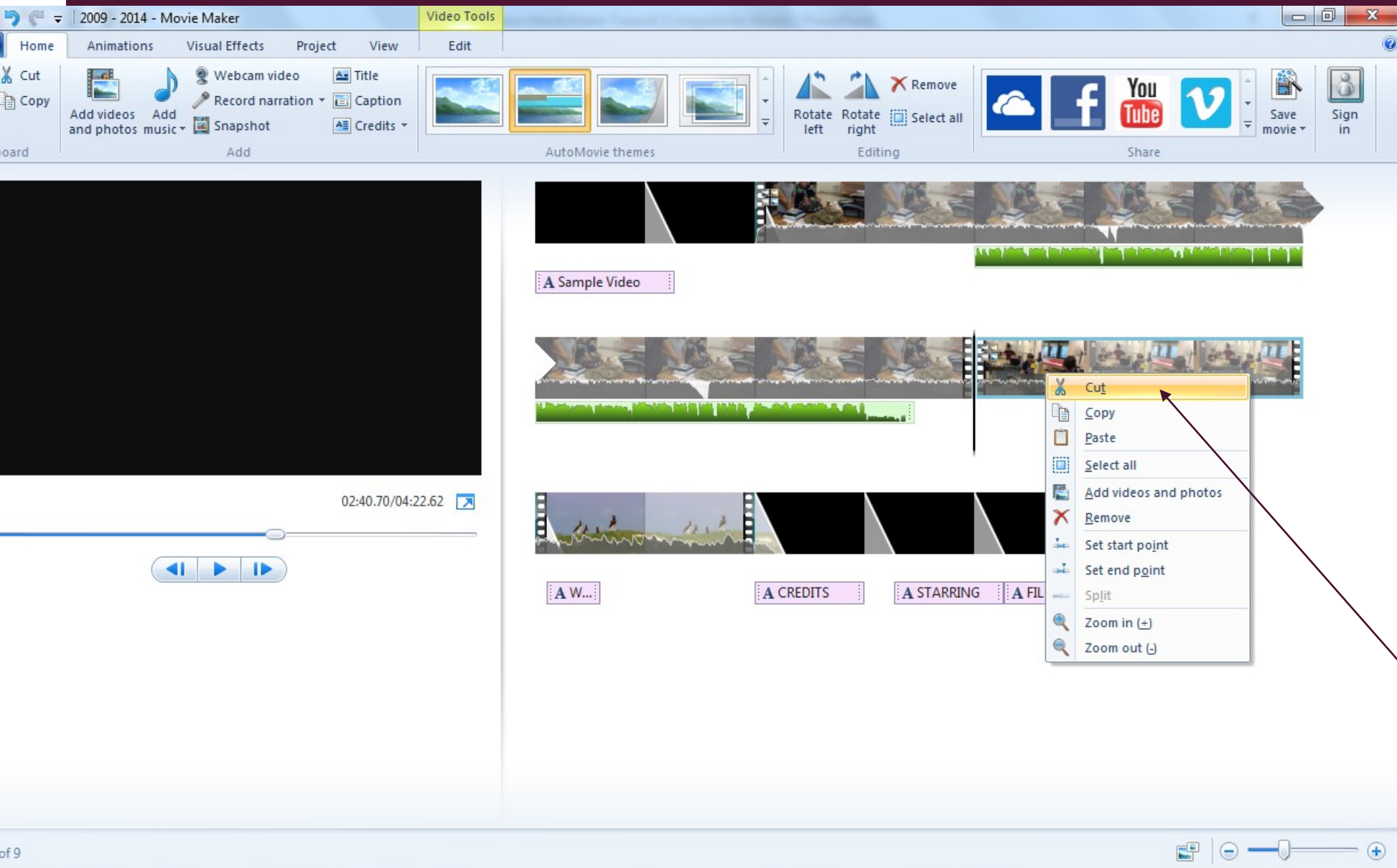
■ Choosing Visual Effects...



- Select a clip
- Choose an effect
- You can “apply to all”

- To split clips, first choose where you want to split the clips
- Then right click and select “split”

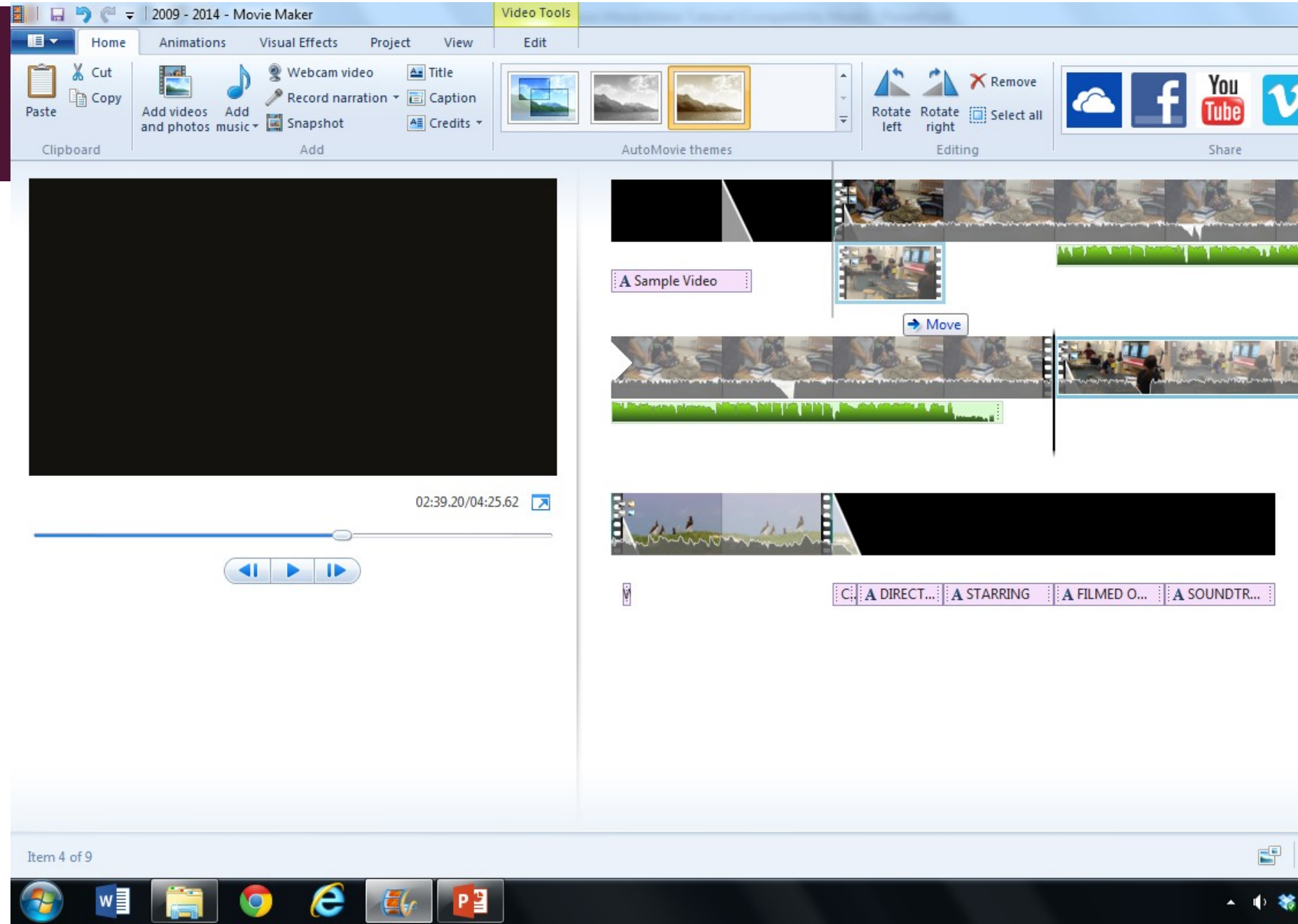




- Splitting clips is great for cutting out parts of clips...


- To do so, right click and select "cut"

- To move clips around – click the clip and drag and drop!

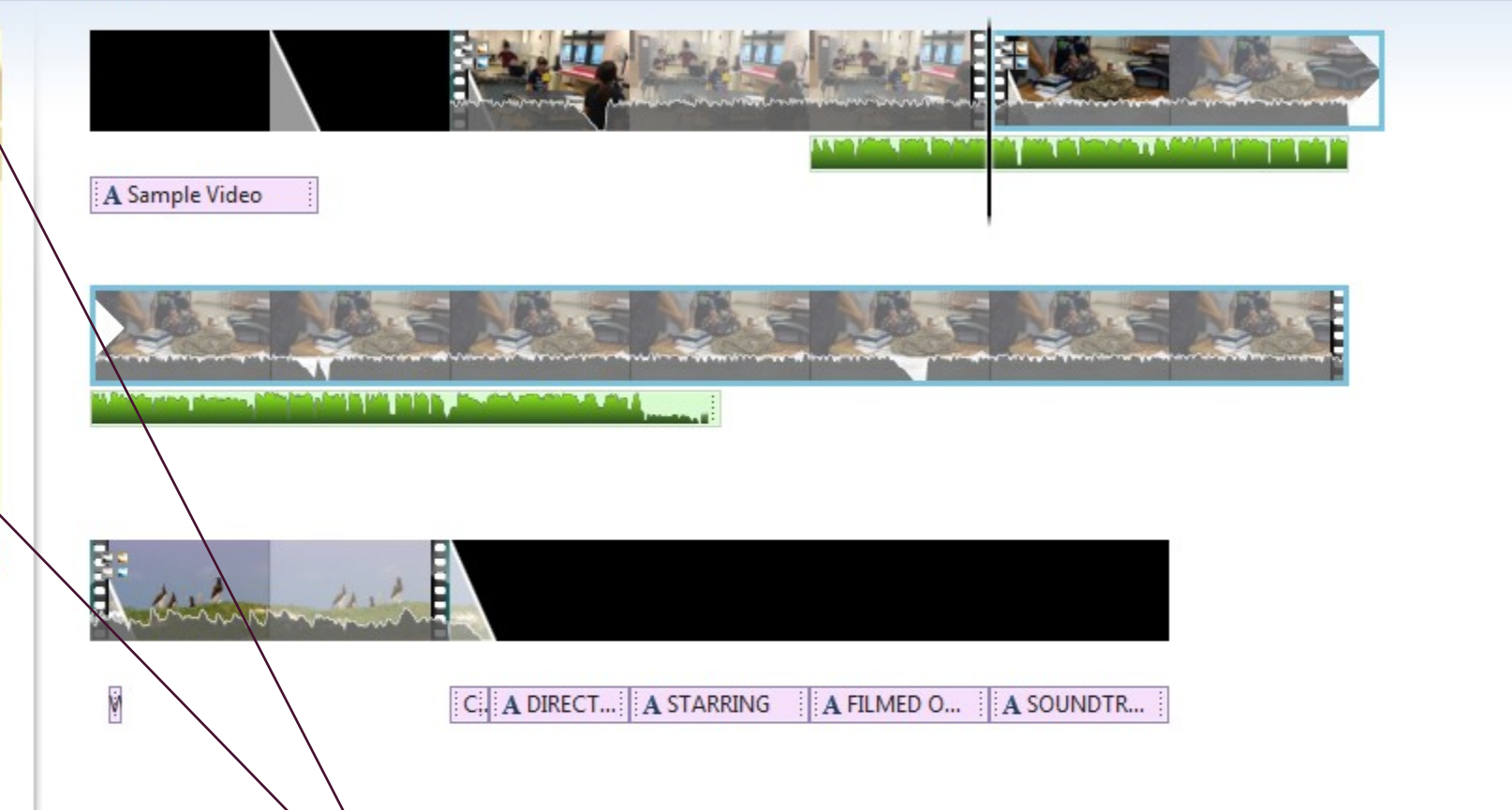
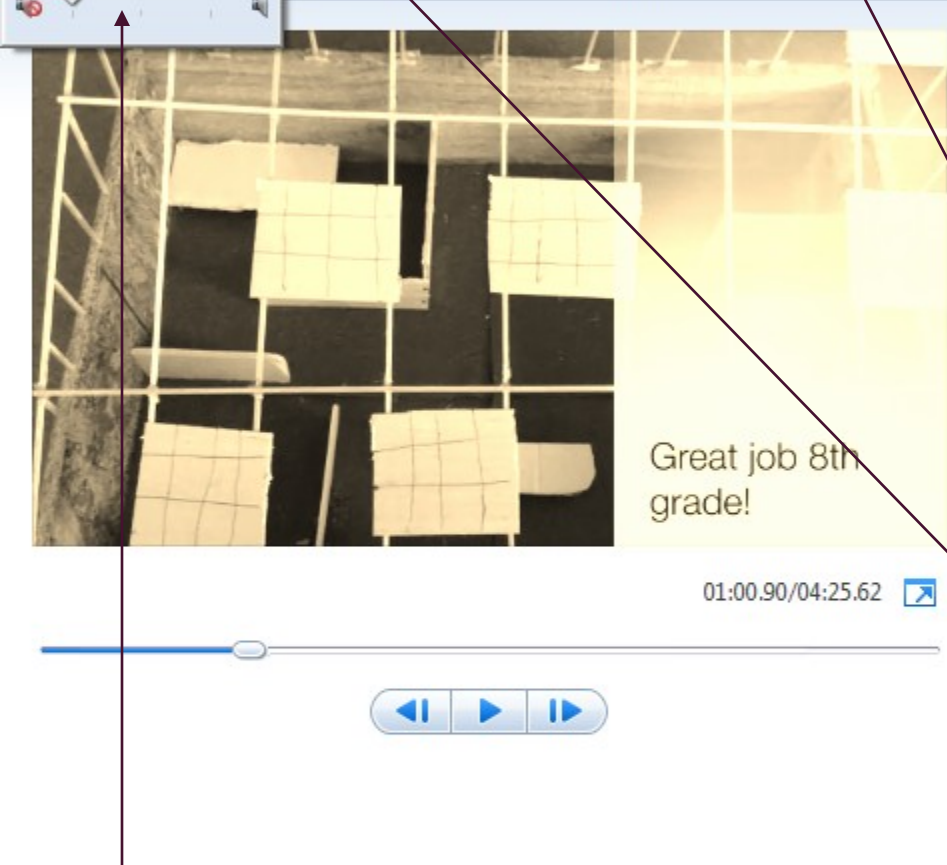
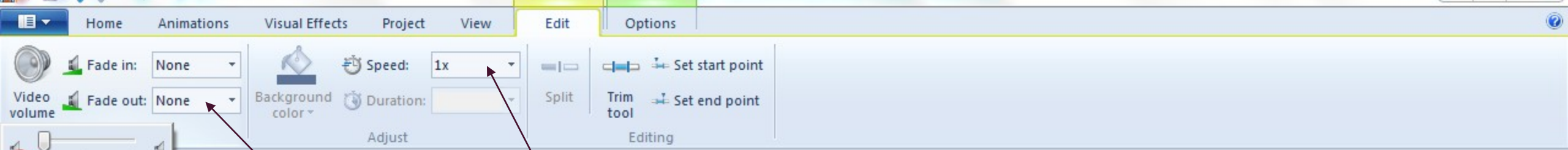


TO TURN OFF SOUND ON A CLIP...

- Double click the clip
- Select “video volume”

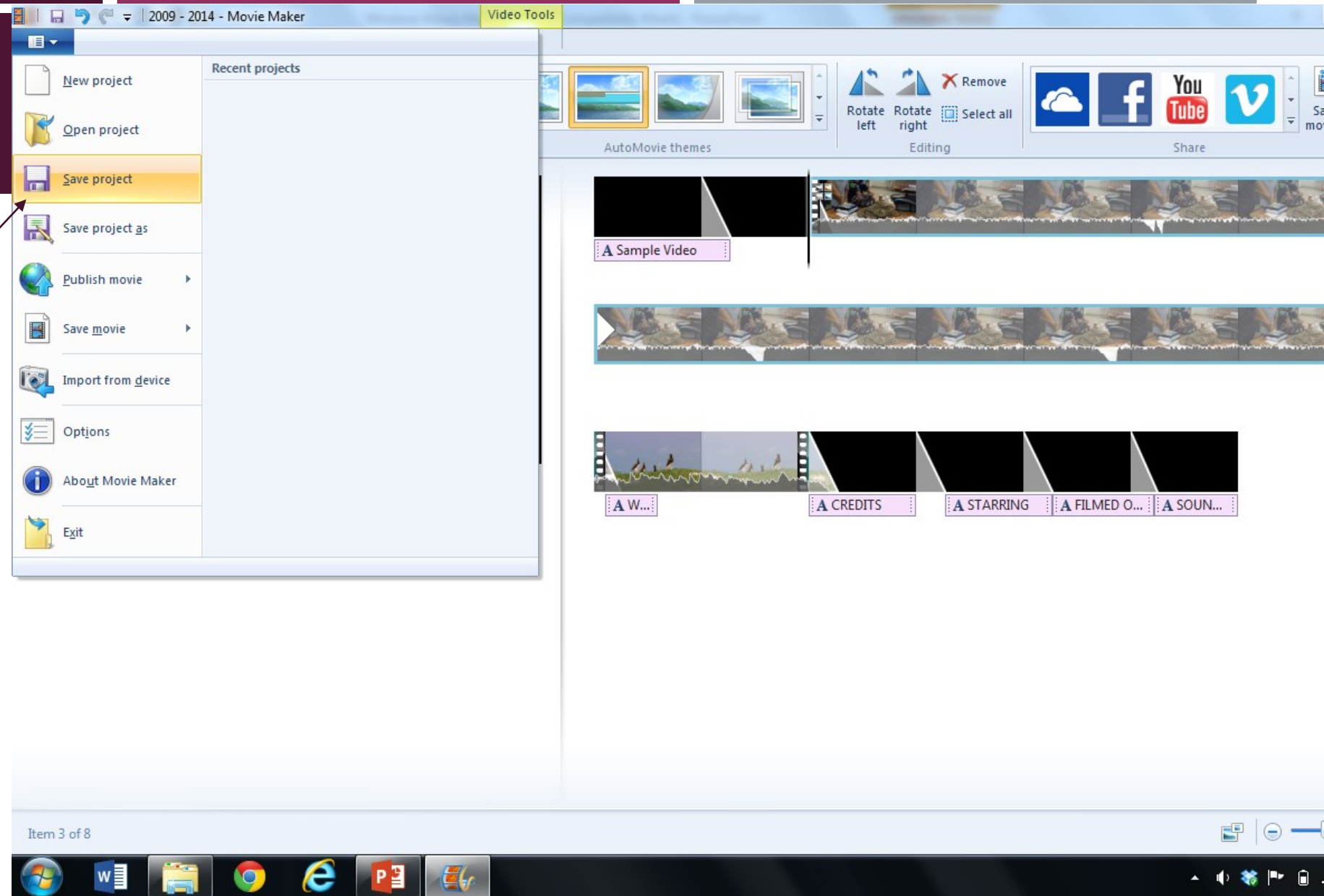


Adjust to your liking

You can also have the clip fade in/out or speed up/slow down

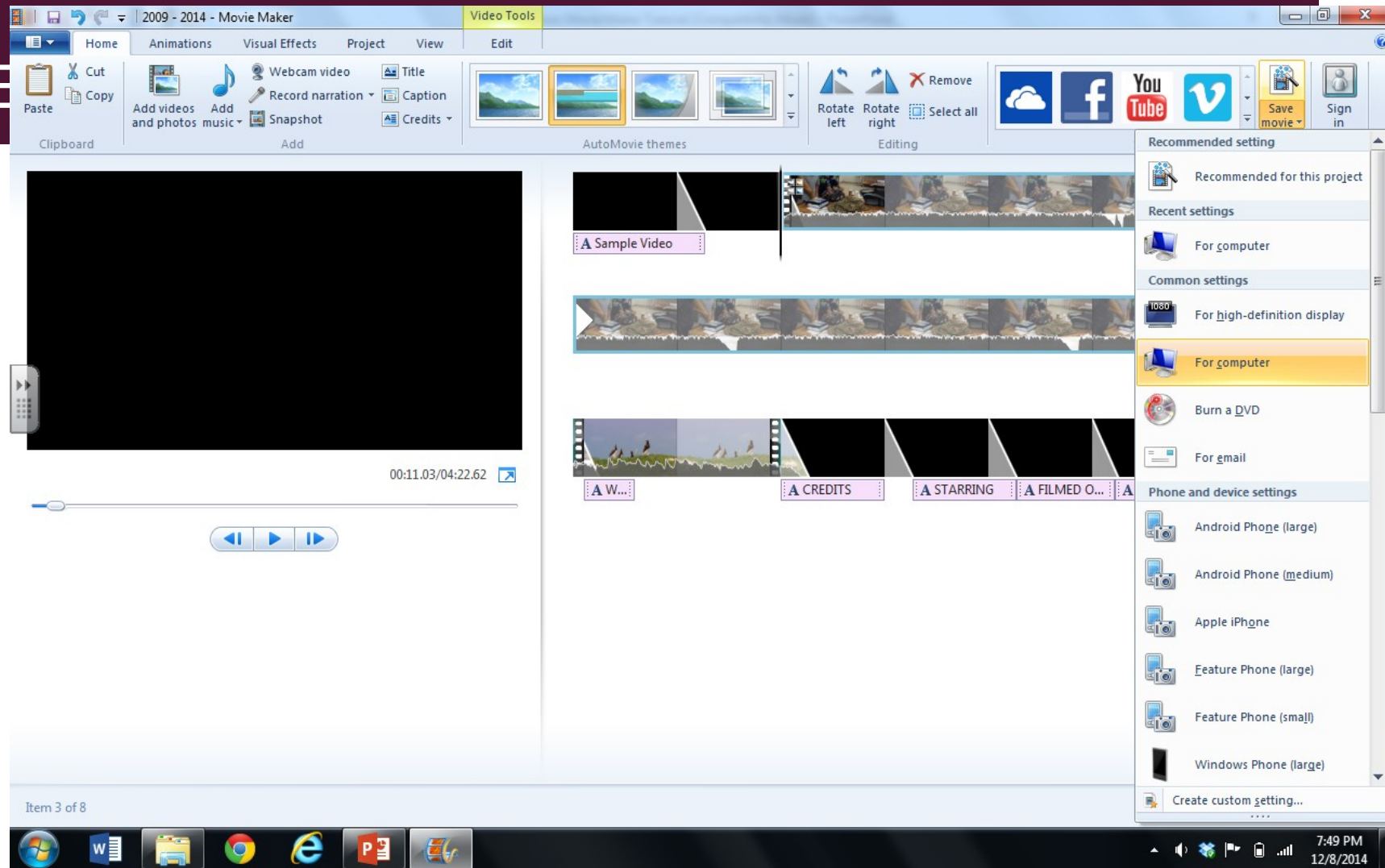
HOW TO SAVE

- Save an unfinished project by clicking the file menu and choosing “save project”



SAVING AS A MOVIE

- Select “save movie”
- Choose “for computer”
 - Can save to a DVD if you bring one
- Save final movie to one of Mrs. Beamer’s flash drives



SOME OTHER STUFF...

- There are many other ways to edit your film clips – explore it!
- “Play” around a bit with the program to become comfortable
- SAVE every couple of minutes – better save than sorry
