### **GRAMMAR** - Conditionals

### THIRD CONDITIONAL

The Third Conditional is used to talk about imaginary situations in the past. You can describe what you <u>would</u> <u>have done</u> differently or how something <u>could have happened</u> differently <u>if circumstances had been different</u>. Example:

- If the athlete **had had** a proper diet, he **would have performed** better. (But the diet was poor and the athlete did not perform well.)
- She would have been very frustrated if she had failed the test. (But she...?)

### MIXED CONDITIONAL

Sometimes we make sentences which mix **second** and **third conditionals**, especially when a past event has an effect in the present:

#### Examples:

- If I had taken French in high school, I would have more job opportunities. But I didn't take French in high school and I don't have many job opportunities.
- If she had been born in the United States, she wouldn't need a visa to work here.

  But she wasn't born in the United States and she does need a visa now to work here.
