Instrument, organ:	-bra, -brum
Specific names:	-ina, -inum -ium (chemical terms)
Activity, its result:	-tio, -sio, -xio -tor, -sor, -xor -tura, -sura -tus, -sus, -xus -men, -mentum
Deminutives:	vowel + -(l)lus, -(l)la, -(l)lum -ellus, a, um -illus, a, um -ulus, a, um -olus, a, um

ADJETIVES: relation +:

Tendency:	-ax, -ix, -ox
Equipped with:	-tus, -atus
Possibility:	-bilis
Full of:	-lentus -osus

GREEK SUFFIXES: pathological conditions:

Disease:	-ia, -iasis
Condition, ill state:	-ismus
Inflammation:	-itis
Tumor:	-oma
Non-inflammatory d.:	-osis
