Title of the journal article or book chapter to be presented

- 1. Summarize the main line of the argument the author follow in the text. Step by step, list the major statements or points he or she makes.
- 2. Use either numbered or bulleted paragraphs. Use only the front page of the handout for this summary.

Concept of identity used in the argument

- 1. Elaborate and explain the type of *identity concept* applied in the main argument of the author: What *kind of identity* is the author writing about and in *what meaning*? What *do you learn about the concept* of identity from this text? How does it relate to the *definitions mentioned in the lectures* and in the basic course readings (marked with a + sign)?
- 2. You may illustrate your points by adding 2–3 short quotes from the text (with page numbers).
- 3. Use only the top two-thirds of the back page of the handout for the quotes.

Comments and observations, critical remarks by the presenter

- 1. Summarize *your own opinion* on the article or book chapter: what did you learn from the text, how did it provide a *new perspective* on the *issues you have already known*, what did you find *enlightening*, *engaging*, *interesting* or *problematic*.
- 2. Use only the bottom third of the back page of the handout.
