

HYDRAULIC FRACTURING

Fracturing fluid (a mix of water, sand, and chemicals) is pumped into the well

The pressure causes the rock surrounding the pipe to crack

The proppants hold open these cracks to allow the trapped natural gas to escape

Gas flows up the well to be collected

POTENTIAL RISKS

groundwater contamination air quality degradation

FRACKING

70 to 140 billion

GALLONS of water used to fracture 35,000 wells in the U.S. each year

equals approximately the ANNUAL WATER CONSUMPTION of 40 to 80 cities with population 50,000

(sand or ceramic beads

or **300,000** to **4 million**

ceramic pounds of proppants beads used per well

various chemicals make up **0.5%** to **2.0%** = **330** total volume of fracturing fluid

 Initial target 6 community owned solar PV projects on schools and community buildings in Bridport, Dorchester and surrounding parishes

Progress to date

- 420kW of PV installations completed vs the target of 407kW in the 2 share offer documents
- Total budget spend £489,000
- Total financial savings to the 12 schools and 4 community buildings from free or low cost solar electricity are estimated at £600,000 over 20 years
