



Indigenous issues in Australia


 Racial issues similar to those in other former British colonies (e.g. USA)

 History of exclusion, subjugation various Aborigines acts stolen generations full blood vs. half-caste

Recognition of Indigenous peoples

- Uluru talks:
 - 250 Indigenous delegates Recognise vs. recognition, consensus
- Document presented to PM Turnbull:
 - never ceded sovereignty
 - constitutionally enshrined voice to parliament
 - establish "Makarrata" commission
- Additional details still to be addressed
