FREEHOLDER can be LANDLORD	TITLE DEED	- owns the land - can repossess the land - charges rent
LEASEHOLDER or LESSEE (is a TENANT) can be LANDLORD	LEASE	- doesn't own the land - pays rent to a landlord - usually buys as long a lease as possible (e.g. 99 years) - can charge rent as a landlord
LICENSEE (is a TENANT)	LICENSE	- shorter and less secure terms than a leaseholder - pays rent to a landlord (usually every week or month) - if he fails to pay the rent, the landlord may be able to repossess the property more easily than from a leaseholder
