Overview of this fortnight's topic

This topic is quite similar to state responsibility, which we have already studied. There are two key things you need to understand:

- (i) *under what conditions does the international legal responsibility of international organisations arise?*

This issue is fairly straightforward. The key document is the Draft Articles on the Responsibility of International Organisations (DARIO):

- (ii) *How do we reconcile the responsibility of international organisations with the responsibility of states?*

States are members of international organisations. States create international organisations, states decide how international organisations operate, states fund international organisations. If an international organization breaches international law, are the member states also responsible? Can both the international organization and the state be responsible concurrently?

It is difficult to answer these questions but there are some clues in the jurisprudence of international and domestic courts. I have given you an overview of these decisions in the powerpoint.
