16 I WAS MET BY THE WITNESS/IMANIS WHO

17 STATED THAT THE VICTIM WAS IN HIS GARAGE

18 SITTING ON THE BACK PORCH STEP. UPON INITIAL

19 OBSERVATION THE VICTIM WAS A WHITE-FEMALE

20 ABOUT 25-30 YEARS OLD. THE VICTIM/ SHOEMAN

21 WAS COVERED IN BLOOD AND HAD A LACERATION

22 1/2 INCH IN LENGTH ABOVE THE RIGHT SIDE OF HER

23 MOUTH. THE VICTIM/ SHOEMAN WAS DISHEVELED

24 AND NAKED, THE VICTIM HAD BEEN GIVEN A BLANK

25 BY THE WITNESS/IMANIS. UPON CONTACT THE

26 VICTIM WAS SPEAKING VERY RAPIDLY IN A HALTING

27 VOICE. THE VICTIM/ SHOEMAN WAS SHAKING

28 PHYSICALLY AND STATED THAT THE SUSPECT/ PARAL

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02 THE WITNESS/ MANIS STATED, THAT THE VICTIM
 03 : SHOEMAN... TOLD HIM TO CALL HER BOYFRIEND
 04 SKEVINGTON, BECAUSE SHE THOUGHT THE SUSPECT
 05 WOULD ATTACK HIM NEXT.' THE WITNESS/MANIKAS
 06 STATED HE CALLED 911 FIRST, THEN WHEN HE HEARD
 07 THE SIRENS HE CALLED THE WITNESS/SKEVINGTON
 08 THE WITNESS/MANIKAS STATED HE DID NOT SEE ANY
 09 OTHER VEHICLES OR SUSPECTS LEAVING THE VICTIMS
 10 HOME.

12 WITNESS @ : STEVE, KETING ... W/M 6-17-75
 13 RELATIONSHIP TO VICTIM: BOYFRIEND LIVING TOGETHER
 14 FOR ABOUT 4 YEARS.

16 WITNESS @ STATEMENT : THE WITNESS/ KETING ...
 17 STATED HE HAD SPENT THE NIGHT AT THE VICTIMS
 18 APARTMENT, AND HE HAD LEFT AT ABOUT 08:00 AM
 19 TO GO TO WORK. THE WITNESS STATED HE HAD
 20 GOTTEN A PHONE MESSAGE AT WORK FROM THE
 21 WITNESS/MANIS THAT HIS GIRLFRIEND HAD
 22 BEEN INJURED, AND SHE WAS AT HIS HOUSE.

23 THE WITNESS @ KETING : STATED HE LEFT
 24 WORK AND RETURNED TO THE VICTIMS APARTMENT
 25 WHERE HE OBSERVED MYSELF AND OFFICER LAWREY
 26 CLEARING THE APARTMENT. UPON CONTACT WITH
 27 THE WITNESS @ HE STATED HE HAD NOT LOCKED
 28 THE FRONT DOOR WHEN HE WENT TO WORK.

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02 WITNESS @ KETING : STATED HE AND THE VICTIM
 03 AND SUSPECT HAD BEEN FRIENDS INVOLVED IN
 04 MED-EVIL GET TOGETHERS OFF AND ON FOR A FEW
 05 MONTHS.

07 VICTIMS INJURIES : UPON CONTACT THE VICTIM
 08 SHOEMAN HAD A 1/2 INCH CUT ABOVE THE RIGHT
 09 SIDE OF HER MOUTH. I ALSO OBSERVED A 2 1/2 TO 3 INC
 10 OPEN WOUND WHICH WAS ACROSS THE VICTIMS
 11 ESOPHAGUS. THE VICTIM WAS HIGHLY AGITATED
 12 AND SCARED. VERTICAL LACERATION APPR. 2 1/2 - 3 IN

15 CRIME SCENE : OFFICER LAWREY AND I OFFICER
 16 FISK WENT TO THE VICTIMS APARTMENT AFTER
 17 HVA ARRIVED FOR THE VICTIM. I OBSERVED BLOOD
 18 DROPLETS GOING FROM 39 BRECKLAND DR TO 51
 19 BRECKLAND DR. UPON INITIAL ENTRY I OBSERVED
 20 THE FRONT DOOR WAS OPENED, WITH SMEARED BLOOD ON THE BACK OF DOOR
 21 BLOODY HAND PRINTS NEAR THE DOOR KNOB. INSIDE
 22 THE LIVING ROOM WHERE 3 STRANDS OF BROWN
 23 HAIR ABOUT 2 1/2 INCH IN LENGTH LOCATED IN THE
 24 LIVING ROOM. UPON THE NORTH EAST HALLWAY
 25 WHERE TWO BLOODY SMEARED HAND PRINTS.
 26 ENTRY INTO THE BED ROOM I OBSERVED A
 27 BED ABOUT 6 FEET FROM THE DOOR NEAR THE
 28 SOUTH BED ROOM WALL. THE SHEETS WERE
 COVERED IN BLOOD, AND WERE WIFE AND

25 white male walked through the front door.

26 At that time he stated that he lived there and

27 said his name was STEVE KETING. I then

I was down in the Basement when I heard a female voice (in distress) & a pounding on my Back door. When I opened it, I saw a young nude woman with Blood on her hands. Almost out of breath, she told me she had just been attacked. I quickly covered her with a blanket that was handy, checked to make sure her assailant wasn't following her; then I called 911. I tried to calm her - engaged her in a conversation - she told me: she was our neighbor (I didn't recognize her at first), MARLY A female "friend" of her boy friend had entered her condo while she was asleep (she wasn't sure her door was locked) and began cutting; hers she asked me to call her boyfriend Steve at work. I finally figured out the correct number and told Steve briefly what had happened. Then the Police arrived Albert Manis
