03 ADDITIONAL INFO On 8/19/ , I, Det. Grimes, was contacted by

04 Subject/Zody-Pline. She verified that she had "tentative plans" to

05 meet Suspect/Nosal in Ann Arbor on 7/30/ . She related that they

06 had gone to Indiana with another friend, Eric Park, the previous

07 weekend (7/27-7/28) and, on the return trip, had discussed getting

08 back together on Tuesday evening. She said they planned the meeting

09 to prepare for an upcoming vacation. She said it was planned for

10 later in the evening because suspect/Nosal was busy doing field

11 research during the day. Subject/Zody-Pline stated that the only

12 time she saw suspect/Nosal on 7/30/96 was after Nosal's police

13 interview. Additionally, she said that, in the morning,

14 Subject/Keting had called asking for suspect/Nosal and sounded

15 upset.

16 Subject/Zody-Pline related the following information

17 regarding suspect/Nosal and subject/Keting 's relationship. She

18 recalled that, the previous Tuesday (7/23/), suspect/Nosal had

19 "mentioned that things were winding down" in their relationship. She

20 added that, on the return trip from Indiana (7/28), suspect/Nosal

21 was excited because she had met a new guy (Waylon) and had discussed

22 breaking up with subject/Keting during their upcoming vacation.

23 Subject/Zody-Pline said suspect/Nosal was talking "like Steve

24 (Keting) was history" and it made no sense for her to attack

25 Victim/Shoeman. Note, she also related that, suspect/Nosal told

26 her, "she didn't think it would work out with Steve because-if she were

27 serious about a relationship- it would need to be monogamous" and "she

Keting's relationship, but maybe felt she had no choice". For that reason, Subject/Ayers said that Suspect/Nosal was feeling the "relationship may have run its course" and planned to end it. Yet, Subject/Ayers said that, during suspect/Nosal's last discussion with Subject/Keting, Nosal told Keting it was possible they could get serious- but she intended to follow her career and he could follow her if he wanted.

Although she is Suspect/Nosal's roommate, Subject/Ayers had "no recall" of any knives owned by Suspect/Nosal. She stated that "all S.C.A. people have them" because they're always sold at S.C.A. events. However, Subject/Ayers said that she'd "never noticed" any knives in Nosal's bedroom or decorating the walls (as alleged by Subject/Keting and Subject/Kelly). Note, Subject/Ayers stated that Subject/Kelly was/is Victim/Shoeman's lover.

At this time, attempts to contact Subject/Park and Subject/Kelly for additional information have been unsuccessful.

03 RE-CONTACT SUSPECT Several unsuccessful attempts were made to

04 re-contact suspect/Nosal for a follow-up interview. Subsequently,

05 I, Det. Grimes, was contacted by an attorney, (TX#

06 761.), who advised he was representing suspect Nosal. He

07 stated that suspect/Nosal was not available and would make no

08 further statements. Additionally, he indicated that she would

09 surrender when/if a warrant is issued.

12 RE-CONTACT SUBJECT/ Keting Subject/Keting was re-contacted

13 and recalled his last discussion with suspect Nosal - concerning

14 their relationship. He said it occurred during an S.C.A. camping

15 event (previously noted-see interviews with suspect and victim). He

16 related that suspect/Nosal was crying and felt that he didn't

17 really care about her. Subject/Keting said he reassured her; but

18 never gave her the impression that he wanted to get more serious. He

19 said suspect/Nosal never gave him an ultimatum or told him that, if

20 he wanted a serious relationship, he would have to pursue her.

21 Subject/Keting stated that he was "always clear that Marly came

22 first, always would and nothing would change it". Subject/Keting

23 said he "did not want a serious relationship with Carol and never led

24 her to believe {he} did". {Note: Subject/Keting confirmed that

25 subject Kelly had dated victim/Shoeman and was her lover.}

04 contacted. He verified that, approximately a year ago, he had

05 observed a couple knife/swords at Suspect/Nosal's apartment - but

06 "not a knife collection". He related that, at the time, Suspect

07 Nosal lived in a different apartment and the weapons were hung on a

08 wall as decoration. He said both weapons were actually "short

09 swords", approximately 20" inches in total length. He related that

10 both were "distinctively weapons" and did not look like tools. He

11 indicated that both had 12-14" inch blades; but one curved, approx.

12 3" inches, from the handle and widened to a heavy "ax-like" end "used

13 for a chopping motion". He recalled that both weapons were very

 ornamental and neither had a completely wooden handle. Note, neither

15

16 described weapon matched the description or drawing provided by

17 victim/Shoeman. Subject Kelly said that the victim and the

18 suspect are both friends and he could not offer insight into the

19 attack because he was "not taking sides".

20

21 INTERVIEW SUBJECT/ Park Additionally, contact was made with

22 subject/Park. He confirmed that he was with Suspect/Nosal on

23 Monday, 7/29/ , until midnight. He said they met at an S.C.A.

24 meeting and went to the "Riviera" cafe, afterward. Subject/Park

25 said they talked about their past weekend at Purdue and, "Waylon",

26 the new guy that Suspect Nosal had met while down there. They

 discussed upcoming vacation plans and Suspect/Nosal's intentions to

meet "Wylon" there. Additionally, he said they "discussed Jewe and how she didn't think it was going anywhere". Subject Park said that suspect Nosal had called subject Keting on Monday night, 7/29/ , because she wanted to tell him that she had met a new guy. He said suspect Nosal tried to arrange to see subject Keting on Tuesday, 7/30/ because she "didn't want to do it over the telephone". Note, subject Park related that he is friends with subject Keting and victim Shoeman, too. He said that victim Shoeman never specifically came up as a topic on Monday, 7/29/ . He related that suspect Nosal "had said she can't keep dating Gewe because he has someone else and that's not what she wants". Subject Park indicated that suspect Nosal had intentions to pursue a relationship with "Wylon".
