

Victim/ Shoeman: stated that Suspect/ NOSA is in love with
Subject/Keling and that was her motive for the attack.
Victim/Shoeman said she has been with Subject/ Keting 1 for five
years and that they have maintained an open relationship, seeing and
sleeping with other people. She said Suspect/NOSAt is Subject/
Keting 's lover and admitted that she, Subject/Keting and
Suspect Nosal had "threesomes" on several occasions. Victim/ Shoeman stated that, lately, Suspect/Nosal has been "wanting more
and more" of Subject/: Keting and his time. Victim/Shoeman
said she thought Subject / Keting was feeling pressured by
Suspect/ NOSG, and she had told him not to let Suspect/ NOSG, push
him. Victim/ Shoeman stated that she was casual friends with

Subject/ Keting . may be involved in her attack and had purposely
left the door unlocked. Victim/ Shoeman : stated that she is
"positive he was not involved" in the attack. Victim/: Shoeman said
she is certain that Suspect/ NOSG . was her attacker; stating, "If I
hadn't seen her I wouldn't believe it either. I wouldn't believe
she's a violent person". She speculated that $Suspect/N05A $. may be
upset because she was limiting Subject / Keting's time with her and
may have thought that she (Shoeman) would forbid him to see her.
Victim/ Shoeman recalled that Suspect/ NOSA once questioned her

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to make sure that Victim/Shoeman was not upset by Suspect/NOSa/'S victim/: Shoeman stated "her relationship with Subject/Keting. words, she wanted to know if I would come after her with a knife". Advised of speculation that her wounds were self-inflicted, stated, "I knew people would say I did" because victim, Shoeman nobody would want to believe that she (NOSA) did it". (Note: indicated that she spent one year in therapy with LIGG DAMES)

Victing/Shoeman stated she last suffered from depression in the fall 25 of 2008 and was prescribed the antidepressant drug, Zolof, but did not She indicated that she quit taking Zolof six months seek therapy. 27

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
