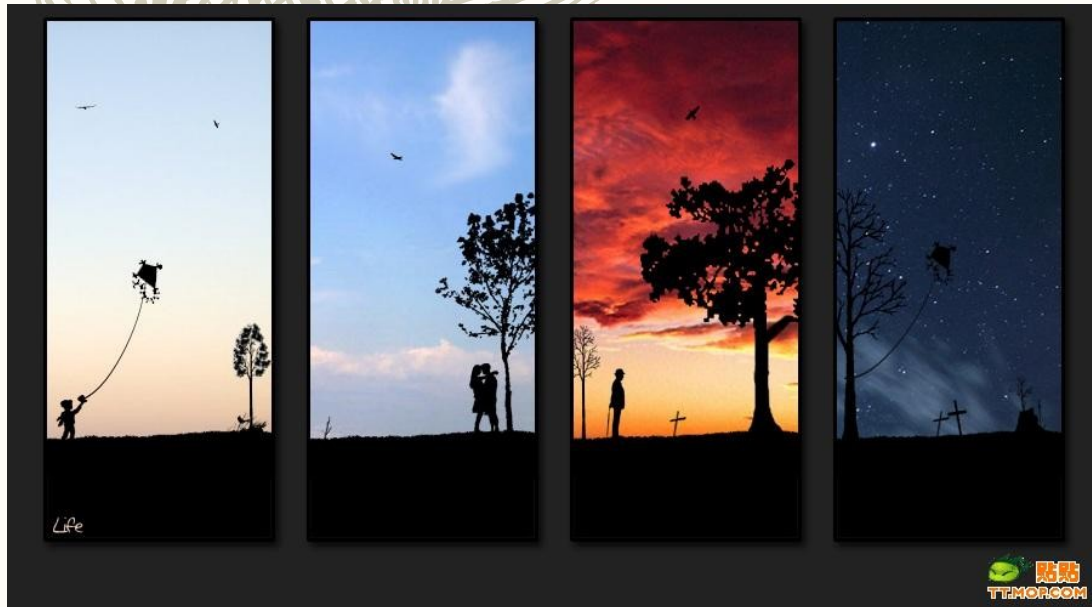

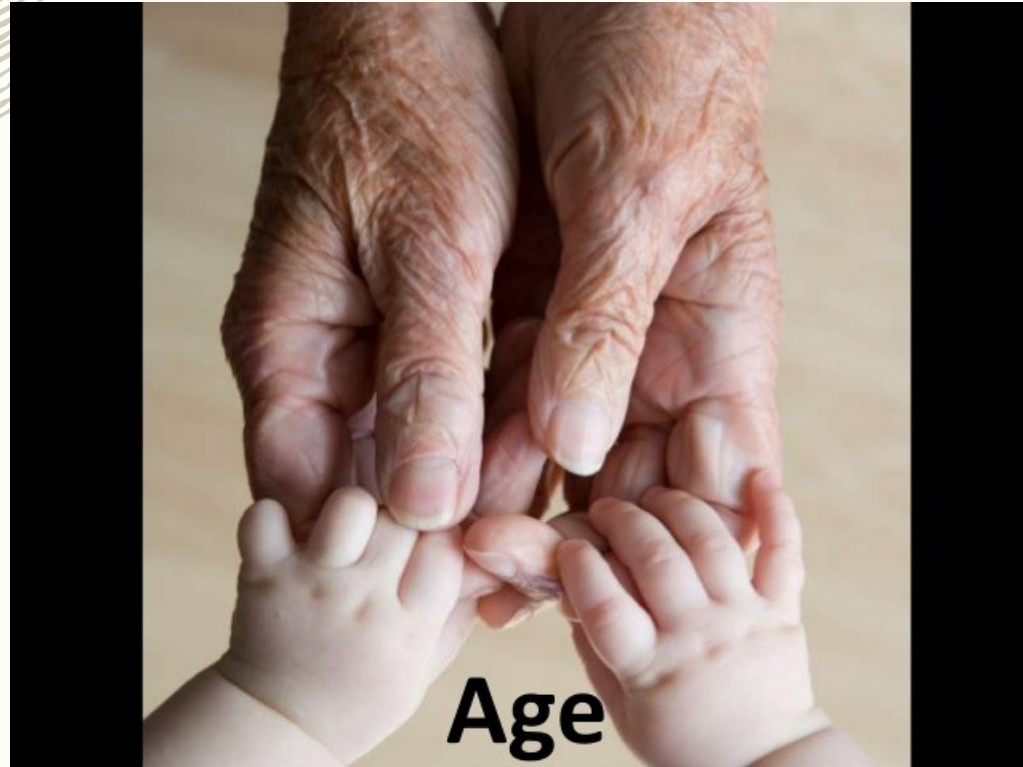

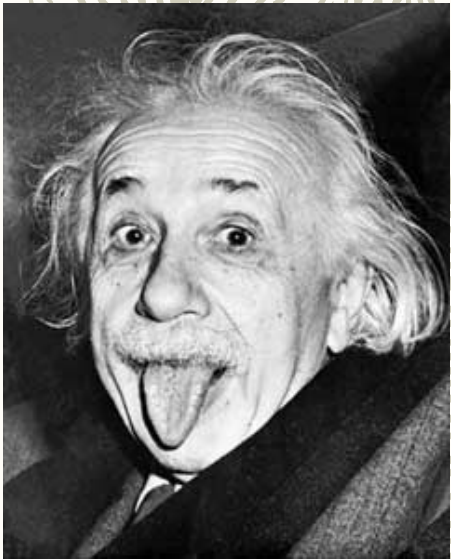
infans, ntis, m./f. = a child

Pubertas praecox

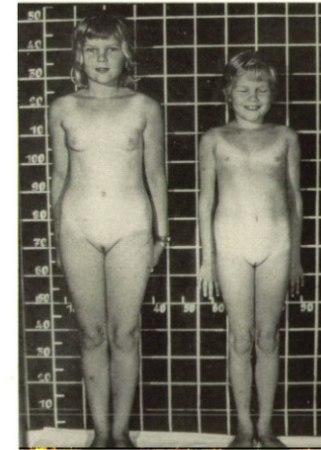
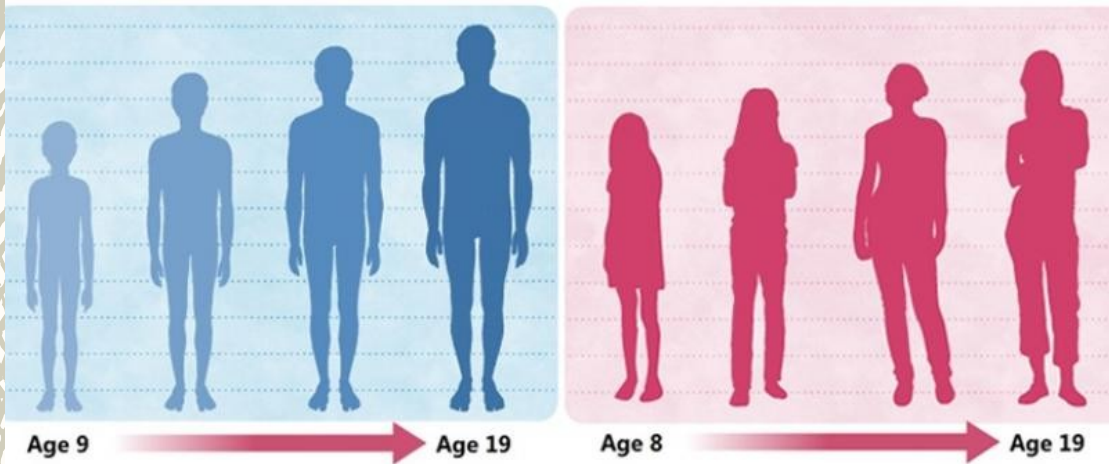


Figure 10. Nine-year-old dizygotic twins; first pubertal signs in the affected girl appeared one year before this photo was taken.
