CLASSES SCHEDULE

ATTENDANCE

- attendance at the seminars is compulsory, in accordance with the MU Study and Examination regulations (Article 9, paragraph 6) 1 absence without excuse will be tolerated
- the absence will be excused because of illness or because of other serious reasons declared to Office of International Studies and documented in the IS
- absence **WILL NOT BE EXCUSED** due to an exam or test from other courses
- missing lessons can be **exceptionally** substituted with other study group after teacher agreement
- late arrivals for classes will be signed to students' cards, if student will be late for class for 3 or more times, there will be a detailed oral examination from all autumn semester topics before credits will be given

GETTING READY FOR THE NEXT LESSON:

- students are advised to prepare for the practical courses with regard to information in the syllabus
- ROPOTs will be prepared for single practical lessons and students can sit the test to check the basic knowledge for the lesson. This activity is voluntary; nevertheless, the professors can check the results in the IS.
- students who are not sufficiently prepared **will not be admitted** in participating in the lesson and must substitute the missed lesson

TESTS

- 3 continuous multiple-choice tests (MCQ) and 1 prescription test. Time limit: 15 min. One resit is allowed in case of fail in one of the test.
- Each multiple-choice test contains 15 questions. The number of correct answers is given. Student gets 1 point for each completely correct answer, i.e. maximum 15 points for each multiple-choice test; total 45 points for all three MCQ tests.
- To obtain credits, the student has to pass the prescription test successfully and also get at least 6 points from each single multiple-choice test and at least 20 points (minimum) from all three MCQ tests.
- The prescription test consists of 2 ready-made preparations. The prescription handbook will be available for the test. The test is rated passed / failed. The test can be repeated up to two times.

The results of tests will be recorded in the IS within 48h from the test. Students are advised to check their records of test results and attendance in lessons. In case of disagreement, the claims should be given immediately.

CONSULTATIONS

- Dates of the consultations will be released in the first weeks of the semester. Students register for consultations in IS in the Topic lists of VLFA0822c.
- Further dates will be specified at the end of semester.
- Missed lessons cannot be substituted in consultations.

CREDITS (PRACTICALS)

- Attendance according to MU Study and Examination regulations.
- The successful completion of all tests (3x multiple choice test of knowledge + prescription test).
- To obtain the credit, a minimum of 6 points for each MCQ test and a minimum of 20 points in total.

EXAM (LECTURE)

- ROPOT - 30 questions with 3 to 5 answers. The number of correct answers is given in the question. The student gets 2 points for the correct question. For bad answers, no negative points are given. A 45-minute time limit is set for the test. The test can be repeated up to two times.

- Oral part – student draws a question from each of 3 sets (General pharmacology, Special pharmacology, and Essential drugs) and is given additional question by examiner. (40%)

The final mark from the aVLFA0822p course contains summary evaluation of all tests from Pharmacology I and Pharmacology II courses. (60%)

PRESENTATION OF CASE REPORT IN THE 14th PRACTICAL LESSON

The student will select a suitable patient to meet at the clinic and prepare a presentation and present it in 5 minutes + 5 minutes of joint discussion. The presentation will focus on the drug interaction or adverse drug effect. The case report and the presentation itself can be consulted during the semester. The presentation will be submitted to the IS no later than 20.5.1019.

Presentation structure:

- . brief presentation of the patient - brief history,
- . diagnosis,
- . medical history,
- . search for medical error (drug interaction, dose, ADR, duplication ...)
- . the suggestion of solution,
- . conclusion
