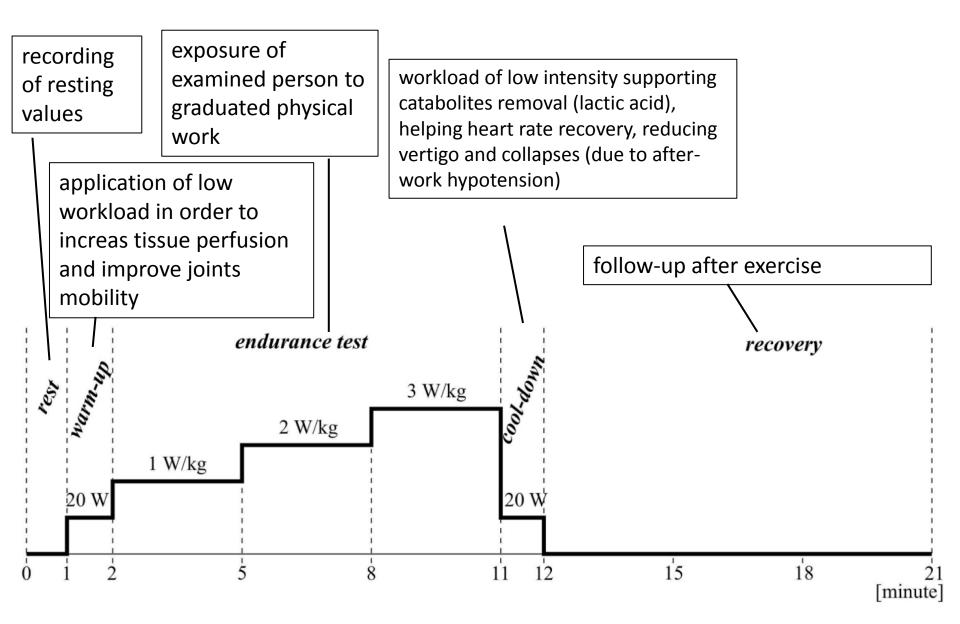
Physiology II - practicals

Ergometry deals with evaluation of performance (work, power).

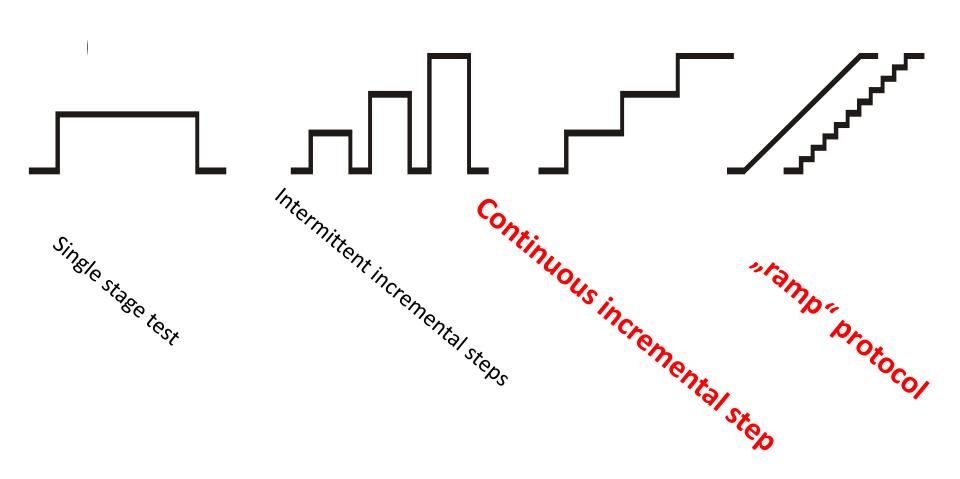
Its name comes from two Greek words: "ergon" = work, "metron" = measure.

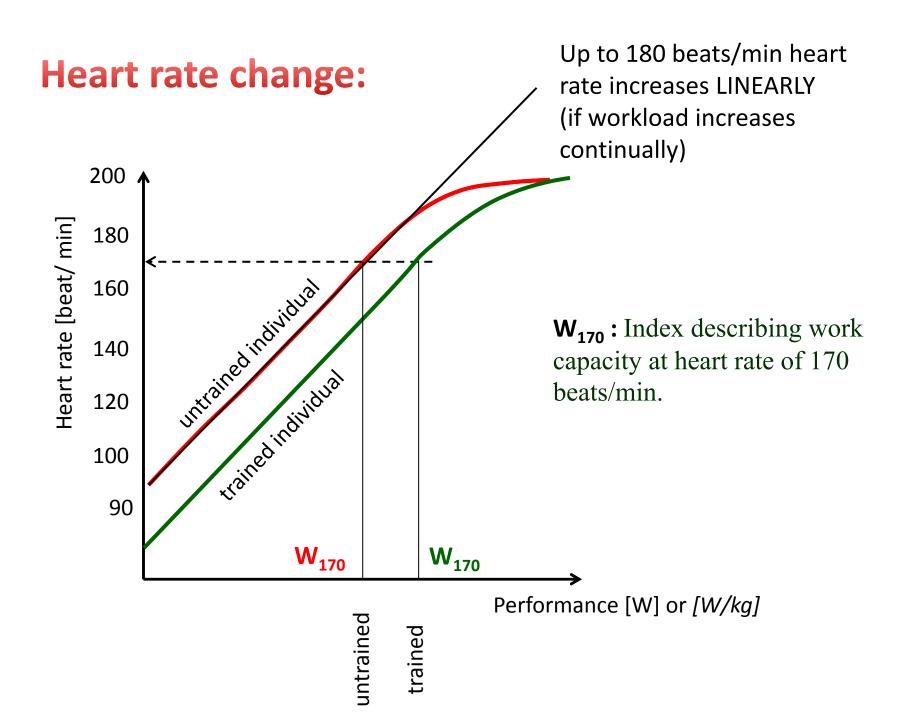
