X- ray: projection, description.

Diagnosis:

**Case 2:**

Patient male, 45 years, healthy.

First time in the dental office.

Diagnosis:

Suggest complex therapy including further investigation if necessary



**Case 3.:**

Patient male, 50 years, healthy, coming to dental office – chief complaint – fracture of the tooth 22.

Suggest further investigation and possible treatment procedures.



**Case 4.:**

Patient 60 years old, female, hypertension. Registered already in dental office.

Chief complaint: pain on bite reg 36.

Diagnosis:

Suggest treatment procedures including further investigation if necessary.




**Case 5.:**
