#### Program:

#### **Intercellular contact**

Mechanical, electrical and humoral coupling, ligands and receptors. Second messengers. Up and down regulation.

## **Resting membrane potential**

Semipermeable membrane, Na/K ATP-ase, ionic channels, gating, diffusion currents, electro-chemical gradient, equilibrium potential. Physiological importance of resting membrane potential.

## Action potential

Local responses, selective conductivity of membrane channels, mechanism of depolarization, transpolarization and repolarization. Refractory period, action potential in various excitable cells. Physiological importance of action potential.
