- Patient -General health -Cooperation



- 14 Metal or adhesive onlay or amalgam with cusp replacement





## Posterior teeth

- 21 – composit, amalgam
- 22 – composit, amalgam, adhesive inlay, metal inlay
- 23 – amalgam, adhesive or metal inlay
- 24 – metal or adhesive inlay



GIC – patients with worse cooperation (disabled, oral hygiene)
