Important remarks:
Basic rules of cavity preparation:
3 main rules:
Extention for prevention – cavosurface margin located in areas where risk of secondary caries is minimized.
Retention – the filling must not fall out
Resistance – the filling as well as the tooth (the restored tooth) must face up to bite forces.
Retention – connection with hard dental tisues:
Amalgam – macroretention
Composite – microretention
Glassionomer chemical binding
Caries danger areas:
Interproximal spaces, areas below maximal convexity, pits, fissures
Habitually clean areas:
Proximal ridges, cusps, incosal edges, areas above the maximal convexity.
