



Renal denervation

- elevated blood pressure despite taking three optimally doses medications, typically:
 - a diuretic
 - a calcium-channel blocker
 - an ACE inhibitor







Asthma bronchiale

a long-term inflammatory disease of the airways of the lungs

– symptoms:

- reversible airflow obstruction
- easily triggered bronchospasms


– medication:

Long-term asthma control medications:

inhaled leukotriene modifiers combination inhalers

Quick-relief (rescue) medications:

short-acting beta agonists anticholinergic agents oral and intravenous corticosteroids.
