Before the test

- Be online 5 minutes before and 5 minutes after the time you have booked.
- Be logged in MS Teams.
- Have a sheet of paper and something to write.
- Wait for my call.

Test: going through

- Answer my call with microphone and camera on.
- your patient card and your test sheet will be chosen randomly (https://www.random.org/integers/)
- I will tell you basic information about the patient (muž × žena, mladší × mladý × starší × starý)
- introduce yourself shortly
- you ask 6 questions about given topics → I answer → you write the answer down on your paper
- if you do not understand, you can ask for repetition \rightarrow I can repeat it once
- the test language is czech: english language will be ignored ©

Test: end

- test ends in 10 minutes (you can check the time on our call window)
- it is not possible to make it longer




- after 10 minutes, you show me your answers (on paper) with your camera: in case I do not understand something I will ask about it
- results will be available after all students in a batch are examined

Important info

- your camera must be on all the time
- it is allowed to use your computer for the test only; anything else (such as translating, checking vocabulary, sharing the test with third person, getting help from anyone etc.) is not allowed
- you might be asked to share your screen in case of suspicious computer aktivity (how to do it → see next slide)
