# Before the test

- Be online 5 minutes before and 5 minutes after the time you have booked.
- Be logged in MS Teams.
- Have a sheet of paper and something to write.
- Wait for my call.

# Test: going through

- Answer my call with **microphone** and **camera on**.
- your patient card and your test sheet will be chosen randomly (<https://www.random.org/integers/>)
- I will tell you basic information about the patient (muž × žena, mladší × mladý × starší × starý)
- introduce yourself shortly
- you ask **6 questions** about given topics → I answer → you write the answer down on your paper
- if you do not understand, you can ask for repetition → I can repeat it once
- the test language is czech: english language will be ignored 😊

- test ends in **10 minutes** (you can check the time on our call window)
- it is not possible to make it longer

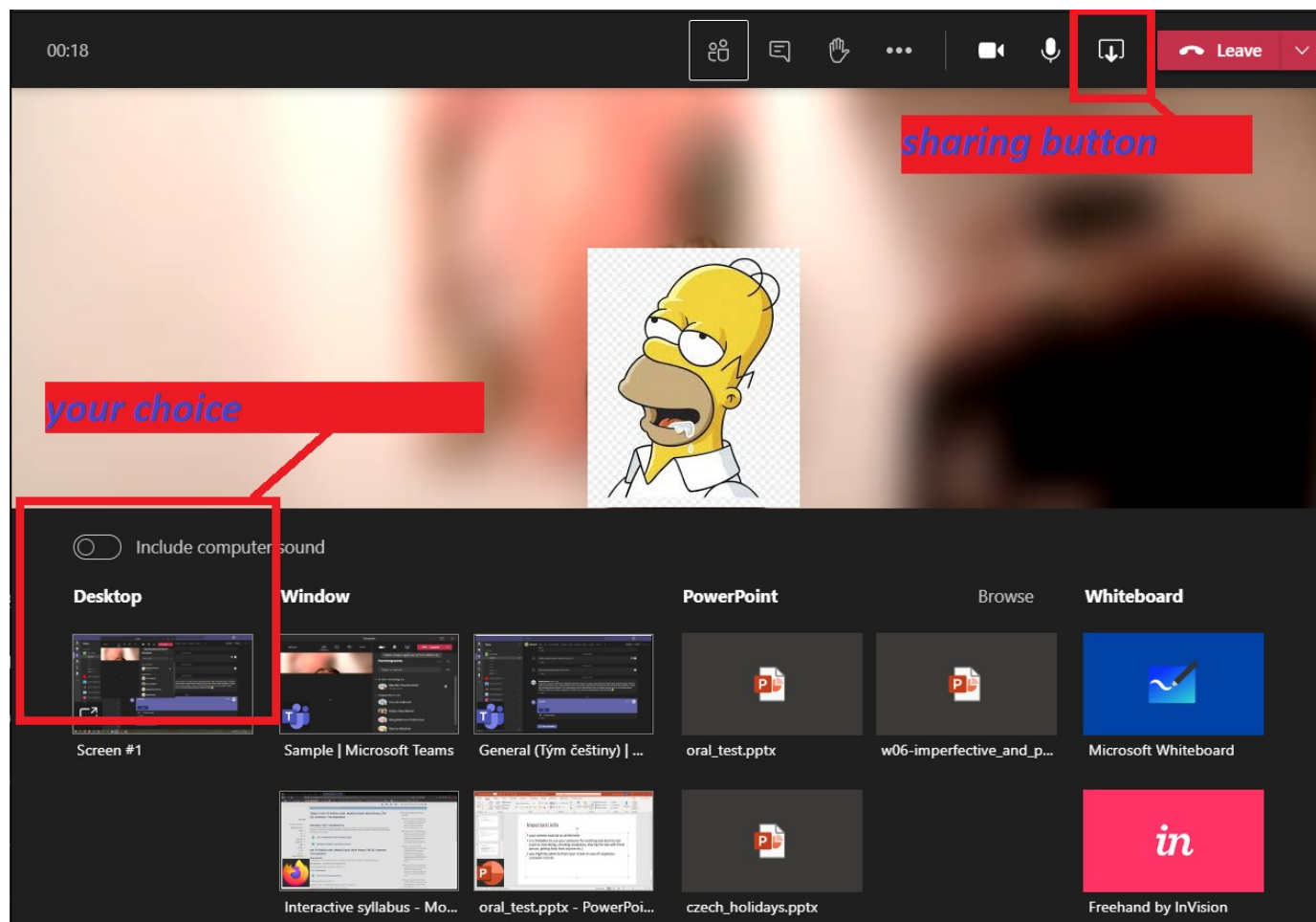
- after 10 minutes, you show me your answers (on paper) with your camera: in case I do not understand something I will ask about it
