Course Description: This course is a continuation of Language Skills 2B.

Attendance:

Writing assignment:
There will be a three page writing assignment that will be due at the end of May. Students may submit their paper up to two weeks before the final due date for a returned (unmarked) paper with corrections/suggestions. Only the final paper that is handed in will be marked. There will be no exceptions to the due date. Late papers will NOT be accepted.

Oral Presentations:
Each student will be required to participate in a structured debate that will occur at the end of the term. You will be given at least one month to prepare, but class time will not be used preparation.

## E-Learning:

Each week, the instructor will add materials on IS that you are required to read/do. Some of the materials will be reviewed in class, whereas the majority will not. There will also be exercises to practice vocabulary and grammar that are covered in the course book and in class.

Exams: There will be two exams. They will cover material from the course book as well as from the supplemental e-learning material on IS. The first
exam will be during the $6^{\text {th }}$ week of class and the second will fall in the exam period.
