Format: word doc, spacing 1,5; font equivalent to size 12 Times New Roman

Deadline: by email, 31 March 2016

### **Instructions: an interview with a teacher**

- Interviewer: yourself
- Interviewee: a real teacher (former teacher of yours, current teacher of yours, mentor at teaching practice, relative, etc.) or a colleague from class who has been teaching for some time
- Topic: the current state of the education system in CR (any aspect of it)
- Outline: imagine it's an interview for a magazine/newspaper/teaching journal; it will contain:
  - headline
  - one short paragraph introducing the interviewee (2 - 4 sents)
  - at least 4 questions
  - answers (that is the length of the 350-400 words), the style should be neither too academic nor too infml (i.e. "*nevertheless*" and "*ain't*" would be inappropriate; contracted forms acceptable)

**Remember**: it will LOOK like an interview, it won't be an essay ABOUT an interview.
