Format: word doc, spacing 1,5; font equivalent to size 12 Times New Roman

Deadline: by email, 31 March 2016

Instructions: an interview with a teacher

• Interviewer: yourself

- <u>Interviewee</u>: a real teacher (former teacher of yours, current teacher of yours, mentor at teaching practice, relative, etc.) or a colleague from class who has been teaching for some time
- <u>Topic</u>: the current state of the education system in CR (any aspect of it)
- <u>Outline</u>: imagine it's an interview for a magazine/newspaper/teaching journal; it will contain:
 - > headline
 - > one short paragraph introducing the interviewee (2 4 sents)
 - > at least 4 questions
 - ➤ answers (that is the length of the 350-400 words), the style should be neither too academic nor too infml (i.e. "nevertheless" and "ain't" would be inappropriate; contracted forms acceptable)

Remember: it will LOOK like an interview, it won't be an essay ABOUT an interview.
