Presentation Guidelines:

- For each conference there will be max 5 speakers.
- You will choose one of the 'virtual' conferences and prepare a **sample** of a contribution; your task will be the following:

1. specify who your <u>audience</u> (eg teachers in general, Engl. teachers, parents, etc.) would be

2. present the <u>outline</u> of the whole presentation (ie the exact structure = main points) by means of a PP presentation/whiteboard/poster etc. and specify what <u>aids/technology</u> you would need (if any)

3. present <u>ONE part</u> of your 'virtual' presentation, ie one point of the structure (it may be the introduction or a practical demonstration or some theoretical background)

4. <u>time limit</u> = 5-6 minutes (strictly!; regular contributions are max 20 mins long)

5. fill in a <u>Registration form</u> and hand it in to the chairperson before your presentation

• You will be assessed on lang/pronunc/struct/content = max 20 points.
